

If you have traveled to

Iran, Iraq, Sudan, Syria, Libya, Somalia, Yemen

you must apply for B1/B2 VISA to travel to the United States



On January 21, 2016, the United States began implementing changes under "The Visa Waiver Program Improvement and Terrorist Travel Prevention Act of 2015 (the Act)". Under the Act, travelers in the following categories are no longer eligible to travel or be admitted to the United States under the Visa Waiver Program (VWP); instead, they are required to obtain B-1 (Business) / B-2 (Tourism) VISA.

- Nationals of VWP countries who have traveled to or been present in Iraq, Iran, Sudan, Syria, Libya, Somalia, or Yemen on or after March 1, 2011.
- Nationals of VWP countries who are also nationals of Iran, Iraq, Sudan, or Syria.

*This limitation does not apply when traveling to these countries to carry out public service as a military or regular government official of a VWP country.
