#### Article 1

- 1. The purpose of the Faculty shall be to encourage students to master their abilities to naturally inquire and speculate through their exposure to front-line research with the aim of developing human resources who systematically understand the configuration of nature and conduct advanced research in various fields of natural science and human resources who act creatively in society based on scientific education.
- 2. The purpose of developing human resources and other educational and research purposes for each department shall be prescribed separately.

## **Article 1-2**

The following 10 departments are established in the Faculty:

Department of Mathematics

Department of Information Science

Department of Physics

Department of Astronomy

Department of Earth and Planetary Physics

Department of Earth and Planetary Environmental Science

Department of Chemistry

Department of Biophysics and Biochemistry

Department of Biological Science

Department of Bioinformatics and Systems Biology

#### Article 2

Courses for each department consist of compulsory courses, elective compulsory courses and elective courses.

#### Article 3

#### Article 4

Students may take courses other than those of the department in which they are enrolled.

#### Article 5

- 1. Students must apply for courses of their preference at the beginning of each academic year and have their applications approved.
- 2. If a course commences during the academic year, students may apply for such course at that time pursuant to the provisions of the preceding paragraph.
- 3. Students who intend to take courses of other faculties must obtain permission from the dean of the Faculty and the deans of the relevant faculties in the designated form within the period designated by the relevant faculties.

#### **Article 6**

If the number of students who apply for one course pursuant to the provisions of Article 5 exceeds the number of students who may take such course, the Faculty permits the students to take such course in the following order:

- (1) Students who will take such course as a compulsory course;
- (2) Students who will take such course as an elective course; and
- (3) Other students

## **Article 7**

The third year students and the fourth year students must take necessary courses as set out in the Appended Table.

#### Article 8

Persons who are enrolled in the Faculty for two years or more and obtain credits as set out in the Appended Table may graduate from the Faculty.

#### Article 9

- 1. Course results shall be graded as A+, A, B, C and F. The grades A+, A, B and C represent a pass, and F represents a fail.
- 2. Pursuant to the provisions of Articles 14-2, 14-3 and 14-5 of the General Rules on Faculties, except for the grades prescribed in the preceding paragraph, the examination results for courses taken at a university abroad may be graded as pass or fail.

#### **Article 10**

The treatment of students who fall under the provisions of Article 10, paragraph 1, items (1), (4) and (8) of the General Rules on Faculties shall be prescribed separately.
