- Researching Indian higher education trends and keeping track of news regarding higher education in India.
- Implementing online/offline communication with the members of the University of Tokyo's Alumni Association of India to promote a variety of networking events and gatherings.
- Developing effective and cooperative working relationships with stakeholders in Indian organizations, especially in the development of human resources in the railway sector.

- Establishing and maintaining effective and strategic communications with external organizations (e.g. Embassy of Japan in India and other Japanese governmental agencies, Japanese private companies in India and their associations, etc.) to proactively search out valuable information for strategy to increase number of Indian students study in Japan, and
- Performing related duties as assigned.

- Fluency in English and excellent communication skills. Knowledge of Japanese will be an asset.
