The 3rd General Meeting of Indo Akamonkai 2018

The 3rd General Meeting of the **Indo Akamonkai** (The University of Tokyo Alumni Association of India) was held from 6:00pm to 9:00pm on Feb.21 2018 at the India International Centre, Max Mueller Marg, New Delhi. 50 people participated in the meeting, including **Prof. Norio Matsuki**, Executive Vice President in charge of Finance, Welfare, Gender Equalities, Alumni Office, Professor in the Department of Pharmaceutical Science who was invited as Chief Guest (holding the “ト” card in the photo below), **Dr. Sudhir Misra**, the **President of the Board**, Professor at IIT Kanpur Civil Engineering (holding the “赤” card), and **Mr. Shrikrishna Kulkarni**, the **Next President**, Chairman of the Board, IIM Calcutta (holding the “ン” card) . Also 11 undergraduate students from UTokyo, one third year in the PEAK program and 10 undergraduate students from the Department of Engineering and 2 Master’s students also in the Graduate School of Engineering accompanied by Dr. Su, Assistant Prof. from Civil Engineering and Ms. Koyama, Project Coordinator in the Graduate School of Engineering.

The new Board of Directors of the Indo Akamonkai for FYs2018-20 was announced and the Activity Report for FYs2015-17 was submitted. A briefing on the action plan for FY2018-19 was given by **Mr. Yoshino**, the **Secretary General**. After the Meeting, memorial photograph was taken and friendship meeting was held. Certificates of Appreciation were awarded to Prof. Misra, the outgoing President, and Mr. Kulkarni the in-coming President by Prof. Norio Matsuki, on behalf of Dr. Makoto Gonokami, the President of UTokyo, as both have contributed so much for increasing the number of the Indian students at UTokyo from 29 in May 2012 to 99 in Nov. 2017.
