At the end of this course, you will produce a draft of a personal statement to be used when applying to Japanese universities.

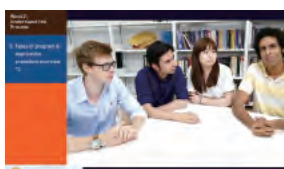
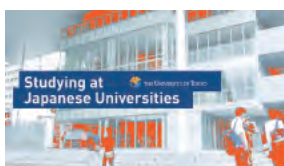
The overall goal of the course is to start you off on the right foot for an enjoyable, productive and fulfilling student life in Japan!
