Online Journal, Repository stand out in search

- There is a search box here → Does anyone here use it?
- Most visitors arrive after searching on Google – most accesses are from search engines
- Better for you if your paper is high on the results list
- Repository and online journal results tend to appear high in search engine results

- Data repository, Open Science
 - We have been successful in publishing basic research data such as genome data. This is divided in specialized fields
 - It is possible to publish journal articles and any scientific data related to that research on UTokyo Repository at the same time, but the primary purpose of the repository is not to publish data.
- SNS, ML, preprint repository, other research community
 - Be seen by other researchers
 - More chance of your research being debated or becoming a topic of discussion
 - Possibility of beneficial interactions with other researchers

- Reasons for avoiding using the repository
 - Journal submissions have to be original

If there is similar research already available online, submissions might not be accepted
 - If you want to publish a book, publishers might refuse your text because the same content is available for free online
 - copyright clearance
 - Embargo
 - Lack of information

Journal Specific Embargo Periods 2015

The following journal-specific embargo periods are set to ensure the sustainability of individual journals, and reflect their individual dynamics.

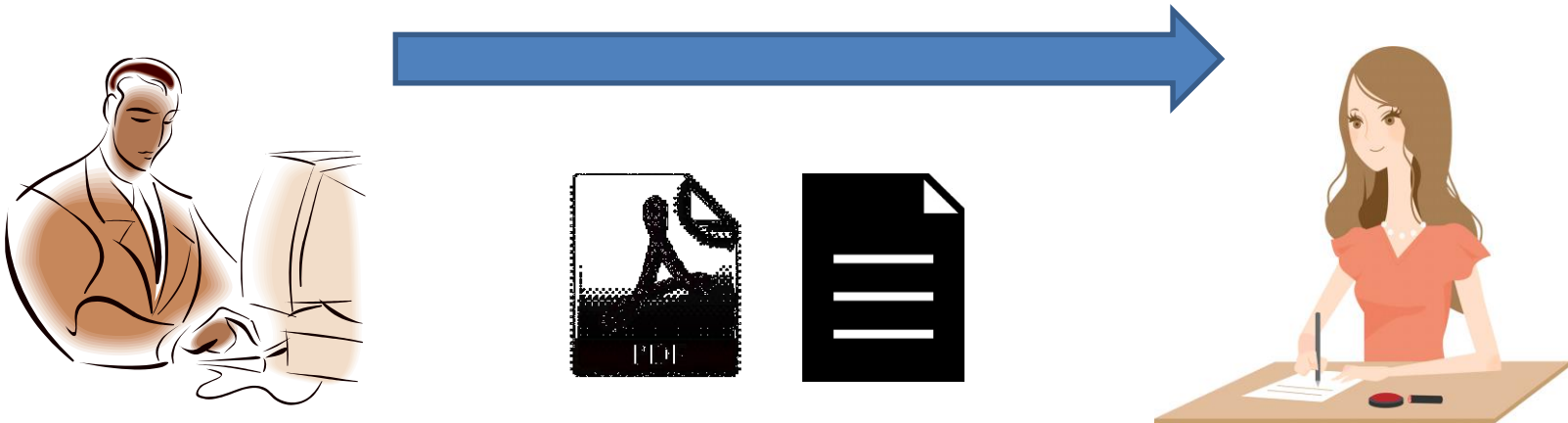

Requirements for Permission of Utilizing Papers Presented to the University of Tokyo Academic Institutional Repository (UTokyo Repository)

(Objective)

1. Manuscript data of the papers (academic dissertation, papers already published on academic journal, etc.) written by the author himself/herself which are free from any conflict of interest with publishers or coauthors shall be registered to UTokyo Repository and shall be released to the public (inside and outside the University of Tokyo) to support for educational and learning activities and to contribute to the promotion of academic researches.

(Downloading and printing of full text)

2. The user shall be allowed to download or print full text of the paper stored in the UTokyo Repository

(Electronic release)

How to check

1. Copyright transfer agreement

- First of all, read and understand the copyright agreement!
- Sign after the article has been accepted. Details about repository publication is included in the agreement.

2. Check online information

Publisher's website, copyright policy database

3. Ask publishers and academic associations directly

Other than the major publishers, usually no way to know without asking directly
