2004年10月に「東京大学校友会」として発足、2008年4月に「赤門校友会」と改称しました。さらに10年目となる2014年4月、卒業生・在学生・教職員を包括する組織としてふさわしく、また国際的にも通用する名称として「東京大学校友会」(英語名称「UTokyo Alumni Association」)に改称しました。

## History

1. The Tokyo Daigaku Gakuyukai was founded in October 2004 with the mission of connecting the numerous active alumni associations formed based on classes, departments, regional association, shared interest etc. of the University of Tokyo (UTokyo) together as partners in cooperation with the University of Tokyo.  
2. The Tokyo Daigaku Gakuyukai was reorganized as Akamon Gakuyukai (Akamonka), a membership style UTokyo Greater Community in April 2008, and since then it has become more active in all of its activities.  
3. In April 2014, the Akamon Gakuyukai was reorganized as the UTokyo Alumni Association with a view to further develop a networking platform.

## Mission

Our mission is to promote an environment supportive of UTokyo, reinforce friendships and enhance cooperation by furthering communication and cooperation between UTokyo and the members of the UTokyo Greater Community that encompass alumni, current students as well as faculty and staff members with an aim to enhance the UTokyo Greater Community.

## Membership

In principle, members of the UTokyo Alumni Association are associations registered with the UTokyo Alumni Association, alumni, current students, all faculties and staff members including those who have already retired. We hope that more and more people will register with the UTokyo Alumni Association, make use of ties with their alma mater and colleagues and play an active roles as a member of the UTokyo Greater Community.

#### TFT (UTokyo Online Community)

TFT is an online directory community unique to UTokyo to which around 45 thousand people including alumni have already registered, allowing alumni to be connected worldwide using this system. Information on residential addresses, mail-addresses, and career changes can be updated on line by yourselves. You are also able to search alumni on line so that you will be able to make new contacts.

Various programs are provided as a platform for mature learning. A wide range of programs are provided, including career support programs by experienced alumni, and Hands-on Activity Programs that are planned and proposed by alumni both at home and abroad, welcome parties for freshmen, 50% off breakfast campaign.



## Interaction

You will be able to renew ties with the University, encounter and make new acquaintances from among the alumni who work in a wide variety of fields and businesses. Events are organized for interaction among alumni and include exchange gatherings for junior alumni, forums for information sharing and opportunities to interact with alumni from other global top universities. Also the Homecoming Day, which is an annual reunion event for all the alumni to get together across the generations, is held every October.



## Publications including online media

#### UTokyo Alumni News (in Japanese)

UTokyo Alumni Association News are issued in paper and electronic media. News about alumni who play an important role in all walks of life, activities of UTokyo Alumni Association as well as activities of alumni associations both at home and abroad are introduced.

#### TFT Mail Magazine (in Japanese)

A monthly mail magazine is sent out to those who are registered to TFT. Informing registrants of the latest information on university, activities of alumni associations both at home and abroad and timely events. Note: Mail magazines for current students are issued on an irregular basis.

#### International Alumni Newsletter (in English)

This is the mail magazine offered in English. Registrants are given updated information about the university, research results and activities of overseas alumni associations.
