

## 授業カタログとは

授業カタログは、東京大学の学部後期課程・大学院課程で開講されている科目の全体を見渡し、あるいはそれらを検索し科目相互の関わりを見出すことを目的としたシステムです。

東京大学では、UT-mate、工学部システム、UTaskなど複数のシステムにシラバス情報が分かれて取られており、その数は学部後期課程だけで4500以上になります。そのため他学科・他学部の授業群から学びたい授業を探ることが大変困難なため、なかなかと思えます。このシステムを用いることにより、自己学習の機会を増やし、各自の目標に向かってより有効な学習を行い、あるいは新たな学問分野を切り開くことを期待します。


## What is "Online Course Catalogue" ?

Online Course catalogue is a system that students can use to scan all courses given in the undergraduate and graduate schools or to search for any of the courses to find how they are interconnected.

At the University of Tokyo, the syllabi are classified and listed on the UT-mate, the syllabus system of the Faculty of Engineering, UTask and other systems. They have more than 4,500 courses in total. Because of this complexity, it may be extremely difficult for students to choose courses from among those in the disciplines and faculties other than their own.

With this system, students can increase opportunities to study on their own, to study more effectively toward their individual goals or to explore new academic fields.


