

## Program Sheet (4) Zhejiang University Winter Program

September, 2019

### 1. Program Objectives

This is a two week program in which students can take part in Chinese language classes, cultural activities, and interaction among students provided by Zhejiang University. The Chinese language classes of this program is held before the start of the new semester for international exchange students who will be studying at Zhejiang University and international students from over the world will participate. Participants will be able to learn Chinese culture and society and will be given a broad knowledge required as a global talent, through 1) Chinese language classes based on their level of proficiency in the Chinese language, 2) interactions with Zhejiang University and other country's students, and 3) activities in which participants can have hands-on experiences of local culture that cannot be experienced in your country.

※ Zhejiang University: One of the universities with a long history in China. The University is located in Hangzhou City, Zhejiang Province.

### 2. Program Contents

Chinese language class: Approx. 20 classes per week (One class is 45 minutes). Students will be divided into classes based on their Chinese language level by the results of the placement tests held on the first day. Classes will range from beginners to advanced level. Also, there are some culture classes, company visits and chances to interact with students from Zhejiang University. For more details, please refer to the tentative schedule.

### 3. Program Period

March 2<sup>nd</sup> (Monday) – March 13<sup>th</sup> (Friday), 2020 (Arrival: March 1<sup>st</sup>, Departure: March 14<sup>th</sup> or later)

### 4. Number of Students Accepted

25 undergraduate and graduate students (If the number of participants is small, the program may be cancelled.)

### 5. Program Schedule (Planned)

### 6. Flights

The international exchange group will inform participating students of the flights requirements\* in the preliminary information session (orientation meeting) or by email. Participating students must purchase tickets for a flight which meet the requirements. The international exchange group will not answer

individual e-mails/phone calls regarding the requirements. The result of the internal selection may be suspended or postponed if students have purchased flight tickets before they have been informed of the requirements of flights, or a flight which does not meet the requirement. The University of Tokyo is not liable for any economic loss caused in such cases.

\*The requirements will include the specific arrival and departure airports (Hangzhou Xiaoshan International Airport is planned, but TBA), specific means of arrival (by air only), prohibition of private travel before the program, restrictions in the arrival and departure times, etc.

## 7. Program Eligibility Criteria and Requirements

Applicants must meet all of the following requirements in addition to those listed in the guidelines:

- (1) Students who are interested in learning Chinese and cross cultural communication. The level of proficiency in the Chinese language does not matter.
- (2) Students who need a visa to enter China must write in the 'Special Notes' column of the application form indicating that they require a visa. See the websites of the Chinese Embassy in Japan as well as the Chinese Ministry of Foreign Affairs for more details on visas.

## 8. Program Costs

Program fees: Approximately JPY 60,000 (Fees will be depend of the number of the participants. Including tuition fee, accommodation, and airport pick up and drop off fee, etc.)

Airfare: As described in "6. Flights", **airline tickets which meet the designated requirements should be purchased individually by each participant.**

※Others expenditures such as meals, personal expenses, and so on are to be paid individually.

## 9. Accommodation

A shared room for two students in a university accommodation will be arranged.

## 10. Scholarships

JPY 60,000 will be awarded those who are eligible and wish to receive the scholarships.

(If majority of the students belong to Komaba Campus, the location will change to Classroom 107, Building 1 (Komaba Campus).)
