

- to help the participants to **identify the factors** in their cross-cultural interactions and communication that can either **facilitate** or **hinder** the effectiveness of their team.
- to agree on a way to work together in order to optimize the team results.

According to research done by Carol Kovach of UCLA:

Cross-Cultural Teams are almost NEVER average. Diversity increases creativity and decreases 'groupthink' BUT Poor Communication often leads to failure



The figure provides some important insights:

- Teams comprised of all members from a single culture tend to be of average effectiveness.
- There is a wide disparity in the effectiveness of multicultural teams: multicultural teams have the
  potential to be the most effective teams in organizations, but they also can be the least effective. This
  is the paradox of multicultural team effectiveness.
