

1. Program Objectives

Would you like to take a real class offered by Australian National University (ANU) with real ANU students? This program offers Go Global Gateway participants who have limited international experiences with an excellent opportunity to do “study abroad.” The major theme of the course is “Science and Society on Geohazards”. While attending this program, ANU and UTokyo students are expected to interact with each other and to develop motivation for pursuing further global experiences or careers. The course is open to students of all classes regardless of their disciplinary backgrounds.

2. Program Content

Australian National University, which is a world-leading center for education and research, and the University of Tokyo will hold a virtual joint program through video-equipped medium Zoom on February 15 (Mon), 16 (Tue), 18 (Thu) and 19 (Fri), 2021 (Japan time)*. Keywords include “geohazard” and other relevant topics such as economics, artificial intelligence, philosophy, and scientific research. UTokyo students will not only attend lectures but also participate in interactive activities through collaborative group tasks with ANU counterparts. The program includes lectures by experts from external organizations like Fujitsu Laboratories as well as faculty members from UTokyo and ANU, and a workshop led by a lecturer who was once a member of Doctors Without Borders. A lecture on the project of “Hayabusa 2”, an asteroid explorer which will be returning to the Earth with a sample capsule in December 2020 through the coordination of Japan and Australia, is also planned.

Students interested in experiencing ANU classes are welcome! No prior knowledge on any of the above topics is required. All the lectures will be offered in English. You do not have to understand everything but keeping efforts to listen is necessary (Follow-up lectures by the faculty in charge and graduate students will be conducted).

There will be an in-person interactive program with ANU students in Japan and Australia next year. Your participation in this program will be factored in the selection process, should you wish to apply for the program next year.

Note: This course is offered with credits for ANU students. UTokyo students are asked to write an activity report and upload it as a part of their Go Global Gateway project.
