I shall not make any objection to the repatriation order resulting from my violation of the terms and conditions for participating the Program.

I. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

1. The Student understands the financial implications of their participation in the program, and applies to the program with the approval of their parents/guardian who will be financially supporting the Student..
2. The Student understands that will not be allowed to decline their candidacy once accepted as the program participant. Student’s withdrawal from the program will only be permitted under exceptional and unavoidable circumstances which the University of Tokyo duly regards to be valid.
3. The Student shall take full responsibility of their own preparations and arrangements required to participate in the Program (such as preparation and submission of paper work required by the host institutions, completing the procedures required by their Faculty or Graduate School of the University of Tokyo, making necessary travel arrangements, including obtaining passport and visas, payment of costs and fees associated with the participation of the Program, purchasing appropriate insurance coverage for the duration of the Program etc.) .
4. For insurance during study abroad, students are required to take out a JEES “*Futai Kaigaku*”at their own expense. (This will not be paid for by the University)
5. The Student should commit themselves to their study or research activities in order to achieve the objective of the Program.
6. The Student shall abide the laws, rules and regulations, and codes of conduct set forth by the authority of the host nation and Japan as well as the host institution. (Use of any kind of drugs prohibited by the host country and Japan and drinking alcohol, etc.)
7. The Student shall take all precautions to ensure their own safety. The Student should avoid any type of activities that may put them in danger.
8. On completion of the Program, the Student is required to return to Japan and shall resume their study at the University of Tokyo.
9. The Student understands that the personal data such as name and contact details obtained by their Faculty or Graduate School and the International Exchange Group of the University head office may be used when the

International Exchange Group contacts the Student to participate in their business (promoting study abroad programs or to advise students wishing to go on study abroad programs) in addition to that required for this Program.)

II. SUSPENSION OF SCHOLARSHIP AND REPATRIATION ORDER

The University of Tokyo may suspend/postpone the participation of the Student in the Program (hereinafter referred to as the “Program Participant”) in the event of the following reasons given below. If the Participant is physically present in the host country, the University of Tokyo may issue a repatriation order to the Participant.

- (1) The Participant violates the terms of General Conditions described in section I above.
 - (2) It has been found that the Participant has made false declaration on their application forms.
 - (3) The Participant is not complying with the proper code of conduct during the Program and is being a disturbing presence to other student.
 - (4) The Participant is subject to disciplinary action from the host institution.
 - (5) The host institution has deemed that the Participant would not be able to make the required academic achievements.
 - (6) Security and safety in the host institution’s country deteriorate.
2. The Student shall bear the full cost of the return travel associated with the repatriation order issued based upon the aforementioned points or on the Student’s own decision to return early.

III. LIABILITY NOT ATTRIBUTED TO THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF TOKYO

The Student acknowledges and accepts that the University of Tokyo is not liable for any personal or material damages and that the Student shall not be entitled to any benefit, payment, subsidy, compensation, or entitlement resulting from any such incidents as follows:

- (1) Losses and damages caused by and/or associated with Natural Disaster, Marine Accident, Fire, Ordinance issued by Government or Public Institution, War, Conflict, Riot, Strike Action, Theft, Isolation, Terrorism, Hijacking, Aircraft Accident, Traffic Accident, Crime, Pandemic and/or Epidemic Disease, Custom Restrictions, change of the flight schedule, Force Majeure, and any other losses and/or damages caused by unanticipated and uncontrollable forces.
- (2) Losses and damages resulting from the Program Participant’s act of violation of law and/or public order.
- (3) Any losses and damages caused by the Program Participant’s negligence or intentional acts.
- (4) Any losses and damages caused by acts not consistent with the scope of purpose and mission of the Program.
- (5) Any losses and damages derived from the Participant personal problem.
