## 1. Program Objectives

Would you like to think about the future of East Asia with students of Seoul National University (SNU)?

This program offers a chance for UTokyo students to attend lectures on Korea-Japan relations and contemporary East Asian conditions with students of SNU, a leading university in Korea. In addition to lectures offered by some of the most distinguished scholars in Korea, there will be talks by top specialists of UTokyo. Moreover, the program offers you a chance to form friendships with SNU students, who will be the future leaders of Korean society, through daily discussions in English. The program will inspire you to think about study abroad and various career opportunities in the future. It is open to all students regardless of their class and disciplinary backgrounds.

## 2. Program Content

Students will attend and participate in classes offered by SNU on February 16, 17, 18, and 19 and reflect on the present state and future of international relations and intercultural exchange between Japan and Korea. The students will also have a chance to interact with SNU students through group activities and collaboratively think about the future of East Asia.

Students interested in experiencing courses offered by this leading institution in Korea are welcome! No prior knowledge on any of the above topics is required. All the lectures will be offered in English. You do not have to understand everything but keeping efforts to listen is necessary (Follow-up lectures by the faculty in charge and graduate students will be conducted).

There will be an in-person interactive program with SNU students in Seoul and Tokyo next year. Your participation in this program will be factored in the selection process, should you wish to apply for the program next year.

Note: This program does not come with any UTokyo credits. UTokyo students are asked to write an activity report and upload it as a part of their Go Global Gateway project.
