And, the following case are able to apply for Occasional Day care of Hongo Keaki Day Nursery and Shirokane Himimawari Day Nursery from April, 2018.

- 1) It is able to register even if you are not employed by, but work in The University of Tokyo, for example, as a joint research member, a visiting fellow, or a docent.
- 2) We accept the application if your spouse is unemployed right now but looking for a job or waiting for entering school. (Being employed and entering school when you use the nurseries are required.)
