

Program Sheet (2) **University of Indonesia Online Summer Program: UI-CREATES**

June, 2021

1. Program Objectives

This is a customized two-week program for UTokyo students provided by University of Indonesia (UI) based on the “Universitas Indonesia – Credit Earning Program for Students” (UI-CREATES). The main targets for this program are undergraduate students, but graduate students who are also interested in the theme of this program can take part in this program. There will be opportunities to learn the Indonesian language as well as Indonesian culture and history, as well as discussions and virtual tours. On the last day, presentation of the group discussions will be held. Participants can learn fundamental subjects for a broad knowledge required as a global talent, through Indonesian language study and interactions with UI students.

2. Program Contents

During this program, students will learn Indonesian language (intended for beginner-level. If there are certain number of students at other levels, there is possibility of dividing the students into appropriate level of Indonesian language) in the morning. In the afternoon, students will join lectures on Indonesian culture and history by faculty members of UI as well as discussions. There will be many opportunities to interact with UI students as this program focuses on interactive communications. Zoom is used as a tool for this program, thus students are required to turn on their webcams while participating in the program. Virtual tours related to Indonesian culture are scheduled on Saturdays. Toward the end of the program, students will participate in discussions and conduct a group presentation on the last day of the program. Those who complete the program will be awarded three credits from the University of Indonesia.

* Note: Acceptance of the three credits transferred from the University of Indonesia to UTokyo credits is not guaranteed.

6. Program Eligibility Criteria and Requirements

Applicants must meet all of the following requirements in addition to those listed in the guidelines:

- (1) TOEFL iBT 64, TOEIC 600, IELTS 5.0 or over (Application without any documents certifying English proficiency will be accepted, but may be relegated to a lower priority at selection)
- (2) Students who are interested in long-term study abroad, taking classes at a foreign university, and different cultures.

- (3) Students who are willing to submit the Pre-program Essay/Post-program Essay to UI.
- (4) Due to the program policy, students who have Indonesian nationality are NOT eligible to apply.
- (5) All students who pass the selection processes are required to submit the following documents to UI.

Some of the documents should be uploaded via Google form.

2. Passport scan (In the General Application Guidelines, the “Copy of pages from your passport showing your personal information” is indicated as “N/A”, but this program requires submission. Students who do not have a passport can participate in the program by submitting an alternative ID)
