

Program Information Sheet (3) **Chulalongkorn University Online Summer Program (ARTS CU Summer Program)**

June, 2021

1. Program Objectives

This is a customized two-week program for UTokyo students provided by Chulalongkorn University (CU) based on a short summer program by the Faculty of Arts, “ARTS CU Summer Program”. The main target for this program is undergraduate students, but graduate students who are also interested in the theme of this program can apply. The theme of this program is “Arts Chula Summer Program in Thai Language and Culture (Online)”, and participants can learn Thai language, culture, Thailand-Japan Relationship, and the history of Thai democratization. On the last day, final presentations on the discussions of the group meeting will be held. Other activities will consist of lectures provided by CU faculty members, virtual tours of historical sites, group works and so on.

Participants can learn fundamental subjects for a broad knowledge required as a global talent, through the above-mentioned curriculum.

2. Program Content

Though the main theme of this program is “Thai Language and Culture”, there will be wide range of learning opportunities about the Japan-Thailand Relationship and Thai history. Participants will decide on their group work topics before or the beginning of the program and prepare for the final presentations through group meeting discussions and collaboration with students from CU.

20 undergraduate and graduate students (If the number of participants is small, the program will be canceled.)

6. Program Eligibility Criteria and Requirements

Applicants must meet all of the following requirements in addition to those listed in the guidelines.

- (1) TOEFL iBT 64, TOEIC 600, IELTS 5.0 and over
- (2) Students who are interested in long-term study abroad, taking classes at a foreign university, and different cultures.
- (3) Students are expected to submit a document to proof their English ability, but those who do not have an English test score can apply.
- (4) Students who are willing to give on a presentation a provided theme on the final day.

7. Program Costs

Free (The University of Tokyo will be covering the program fees)

8. Orientation

All students who pass the selection processes are required to attend a preliminary information session (orientation meeting) regarding this program that will be held on Thursday, August 12th from 5:00 pm to 6:00 pm online.
