

Program Sheet (2) Zhejiang University Online Winter Program

1. Program Objectives

We seek applications from students who are interested in attending a 10-days online program in which students can take part in Chinese language classes, cultural activities, and interaction among students provided by Zhejiang University. Participants will be able to learn about Chinese culture and society and will be given a broad knowledge required to become a global citizen through the program.

*Zhejiang University: A prominent university with a long history in China. The University is located in Hangzhou City, Zhejiang Province.

2. Program Contents

Chinese language class: Approx. 4 classes per week (One class is 60 minutes which includes a 5-minute break). Also, there are some culture classes, virtual visits, discussions, and chances to interact with students from Zhejiang University and other participating universities. For more details, please refer to the attached schedule. (The schedule is tentative and subject to possible changes).

3. Program Period

February 15th (Tuesday) – February 25th (Friday) 2022 (JST 15:00-18:30)

4. Number of Students Accepted

25 undergraduate and graduate students. (If the number of applicants is small, the program may be cancelled.)

6. Program Eligibility Criteria and Requirements

Applicants must meet all the following requirements in addition to those listed in the guidelines:

- (1) Beginners and elementary-level learners of Chinese language are welcome to apply, but applicants must be interested in the Chinese language and Chinese culture.
- (2) Non-Chinese citizens.
- (3) Students must possess sufficient proficiency in English to attend lectures in English and to conduct discussion (TOEFL iBT 64, TOEIC 600, IELTS 5.0 or over). Application without any documents certifying English proficiency will be accepted. Proof of applicants' proficiency in Chinese is not required.
- (4) Students must be able to use the applications required during the program (DingTalk).
- (5) All students who pass the internal selection process are required to complete an online application form and submit required documents to Zhejiang University by the deadline.

7. Program Costs

Free (The University of Tokyo covers the program fees)

8. Preliminary information session (Orientation Meeting)

All students who pass the internal selection process are required to attend a preliminary information session (orientation meeting) regarding this program that will be held online around early-February 2022.

9. Post-program Reports

Within two weeks of completing the program, participants must submit the reports listed below.

- (1) All students: A report in a format prescribed by the International Exchange Group of the UTokyo Administration Bureau
- (2) Undergraduate students enrolled after April AY 2018: An activity report on this program on category 2 "Classes/Courses" or category 4 "International Activities" of the Go Global Gateway (GGG) program
