1. Program Objectives

Would you like to think about the future of East Asia with students from Seoul National University (SNU)? This program offers UTokyo students an opportunity to think of a constructive partnership between Japan and South Korea through attending lectures on Japan-South Korea relations and current issues in East Asia with students from SNU, a leading university in South Korea. In addition to the lectures offered by some of the most distinguished scholars in South Korea, there will be talks given by UTokyo faculty members. Moreover, the program gives you a chance to be friends with SNU students, who will be future leaders of South Korean society, through daily discussions in English. The program will inspire you to think about studying abroad and various career opportunities in the future. This program welcomes students in any year or majors.

2. Program Content

Seoul National University and The University of Tokyo will jointly deliver this online winter program. Participants will discuss the present and future relationship between Japan and South Korea. In addition, UTokyo students will interact with SNU students through groupwork and cultural exchange sessions. This program welcomes students who are motivated to learn about international relations and exchange opinions with students from overseas universities. Specialized disciplinary knowledge is not necessary to participate in this program. All lectures and discussions will be delivered in English.

6. Program Eligibility Criteria and Requirements

Applicants must meet all the following requirements in addition to those listed on the General Application Guidelines:

- (1) Undergraduate students who have registered for the Go Global Gateway (GGG) program and have already had their Go Global Statement approved (see General Application Guidelines)
- (2) Undergraduate students with an intermediate level of English (equivalent to B1 B2 on CEFR)
- (3) Undergraduate students who are interested in taking lectures at overseas universities, learning the English language, and experiencing different cultures
- (4) Undergraduate students who are able to use Zoom and other online conferencing/meeting applications

7. Program Costs

An orientation session will be held on Zoom after the internal selection. All participants will be required to attend the orientation session.
