

1. Program Objectives

Asian University for Women* and The University of Tokyo will jointly host an online winter program for undergraduate students from both institutions. Guided by the overall theme “Conceptualizing Gender (with a focus on Feminism)”, this program offers students basic academic understanding of gender and feminism, as well as opportunities to exchange ideas and experiences about gender and related social issues. By bringing students of diverse backgrounds across borders and institutions, the program offers an exciting opportunity for participants to gain a better grasp of dynamics of gender, which conditions our lives in fundamental ways. Specialized disciplinary knowledge on gender studies is not necessary and students in any year or majors are welcome.

*Asian University for Women is situated in Chattogram, Bangladesh. The university was established in 2008 to give women educational opportunities and nurture their leadership. The institution offers Liberal Arts curricula to women from 18 nations.

2. Program Content

This program runs for three days. Day 1 and Day 2 consist of lectures conducted/delivered by professors from both universities and workshops for participants to interact with each other. On Day 3, participants will give group presentations as an outcome of this program. Upon successful completion of the program, students will be awarded a certificate of completion.

6. Program Eligibility Criteria and Requirements

Applicants must meet all the following requirements in addition to those listed on the General Application Guidelines:

- (1) Undergraduate students who have registered for the Go Global Gateway (GGG) program and have already had their Go Global Statement approved (See General Application Guidelines)
- (2) Undergraduate students with an intermediate level of English (equivalent to B1 - B2 on CEFR)
- (3) Undergraduate students who are interested in taking lectures at overseas universities, learning the English language, and experiencing different cultures
- (4) Undergraduate students who are able to use Zoom and other online conferencing/meeting applications

7. Program Costs

Free (UTokyo will cover program fees)

8. Orientation Session

An orientation session will be held on Zoom in Early - Mid February 2022. All participants will be required to attend the orientation session. The exact date will be noticed to participants after the internal selection.

9. Post-program Reports

Students must submit a report (in a format prescribed by the International Exchange Group of the UTokyo Administration Bureau) and an Activity Report of Go Global Gateway Program. The Activity Report must be submitted on category 2 "Classes/Courses" or category 4 "International Activities".
