Program Sheet (7) Australian National University and the University of Tokyo Joint Online Winter Program

1. Program Objectives

Would you like to take online classes offered by the Australian National University (ANU)? This program offers a virtual "study abroad" experience to students with limited international experiences. Guided by the overall theme of "Coexistence", this program provides students with an opportunity to learn about diverse topics such as the culture and history of Japanese and Australian native people, and the recovery from the Great East Japan Earthquake and its impact on the environment. In this program, UTokyo students interact with ANU students and increase the motivation for pursuing further global experiences or careers. The course is open to students of all years regardless of their disciplinary backgrounds.

2. Program Content

Australian National University, which is a world-leading center for education and research, and the University of Tokyo will hold a virtual joint program through the video-equipped medium Zoom on February 21 (Mon), 22 (Tue), 24 (Thu), and 25 (Fri), 2022 (Japan time). Guided by the overall theme, "Coexistence", this program offers students an opportunity to learn about various subthemes, such as "environment", "natural hazards", and "cultural diversity". UTokyo students will attend lectures given by faculty members from both institutions and participate in interactive activities through collaborative group tasks with ANU students.

Students interested in experiencing ANU classes are welcome! No prior knowledge of the above-mentioned topics is required. All the lectures will be offered in English. You may not comprehend the content of the lectures perfectly but you need to keep trying to understand the lectures.

UTokyo students are required to write an activity report and upload it as a part of their Go Global Gateway project.

- (3) Undergraduate students who are interested in taking lectures at overseas universities, learning the English language and experiencing different cultures.
- (4) Undergraduate students who are able to use Zoom and other online conferencing/meeting applications.

Students must submit a report (in a format prescribed by the International Exchange Group of the UTokyo Administration Bureau) and an Activity Report of Go Global Gateway Program. The Activity Report must be submitted on category 2 "Classes/Courses" or category 4 "International Activities".
