2. Eligibility Criteria and Requirements

- Students who are enrolled as full-time undergraduate* and postgraduate students of UTokyo during the period of the program. *Undergraduate students who enrolled in or after April of 2018 must register for Go Global Gateway (including submission and approval of Go Global Statement prior to your application)
- Applicants may apply to the programs only after they have confirmed that it is possible for them to participate throughout the period.
- Applicants must consult with the relevant section of the College, Faculty, or Graduate School with which they will be affiliated during the program in order to receive explanations on the points to be noted concerning the program., etc.

3. Program Costs

- Participants are responsible for bearing all the costs. See each program's information sheet and the following program introduction slides for details.

4. Scholarships (Face-to-face programs only. Non-repayment type)

- If students meet the designated criteria (Grading Coefficient of AY 2021, etc.) and wish to receive scholarships, they are eligible to receive the scholarships.
- Payment will be made after completion of the study abroad programs (details will be announced to the prospective participants).

5. Application Procedure • Deadlines

- Apply/view via UTAS "Overseas Study" (Not the smartphone page)

Matters common to all programs ③

6. Internal Selection and competition rate

- Selection will be based on your application documents. Applicants can apply to up to three programs. The screening puts more weight on the contents of the application documents than the English proficiency/scores. (This program does not require submission of language proficiency scores, but those who have scores are recommended to submit them.)
- Ensuring sufficient diversity may be considered during the selection process
- There are 6 programs, approx. 130 participants in total
- Participation in this Summer Programs has no impact on future internal selection for the programs offered by the Division of Global Campus Initiatives such as University-wide Student Exchange Program (USTEP)
- 2019's Summer Programs (all face-to-face): 204 applicants to a capacity of 134 in total for 7 programs. More than the original accepted selected with a competition rate of approx. 1.15.
- 2021's Online Summer Programs: 135 applicants to capacity of 65 in total for 4 programs. More than the original capacity accepted with a competition rate of approx. 1.8.

Matters common to all programs ④

7. Insurance • Emergency Service (OSSMA)

- Selected students for face-to-face programs are required to take out the “Futai Kaigaku” from Japan Educational Exchanges and Services (JEES) and “OSSMA” (Overseas Student Safety Management Assistance) throughout the travel period until arriving home in Japan including private travel at their own expense (this will not be paid for by the University)
✂insurance premium...approx. JPY 9,000/4 weeks, “OSSMA”... JPY 3,300/1 month

8. Notes

- Applicants for face-to-face programs must submit two types of Oaths which requires signature/seal (digital signature/seal is acceptable) of Parents/Guardians
- Make sure to read the Application Guidelines and Oaths carefully.

- Please allow enough time for submission as the Go Global Statement may not be approved in one go.

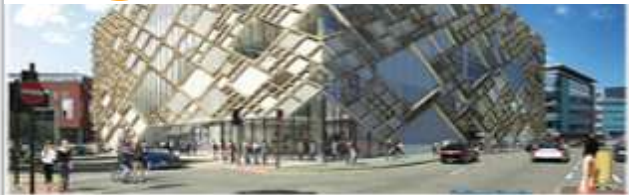

University of Indonesia Online Summer Program ①

1. Program Objectives/Contents (subject to change)

- To learn the Indonesian language (intended for beginner-level)
- Lectures on Indonesian culture and history and discussion
- Virtual tours related to Indonesian culture
- Those who complete the program will be awarded three credits* from the University of Indonesia.

* Note: Acceptance of the three credits transferred from the University of Indonesia to UTokyo credits is not guaranteed.



2. Eligibility criteria

- Undergraduate and graduate students
- Number of students accepted: approx. 20
- Intermediate English learner (Minimum of TOEFL iBT 64, TOEIC 600, or IELTS 5.0)
- Students who are interested in a long-term study abroad, learning English and cross-cultural understanding
- Cf. the program's information sheet for other criteria

3. Cost · Scholarship

- (Details will be confirmed later) Program fee: about USD 350 (approx. JPY 50,000) ✕It may increase depending on the number of the participant.
- Students accepted into one of the online programs may apply for “Go Global Scholarships for Online Course Programs offered by Overseas Institutions” (Details will be announced around late May – June.)

4. From the coordinator

- Orientation: Held online for about an hour around mid-July or late-July. All students who pass the selection processes are required to attend
- Feedback from AY2021 participants: Overall satisfaction rate is 9.2 out of 10! “I could learn both Indonesian language and culture in a good balance and experience similar to study on-site in terms of interaction with local students.”, “I was motivated by not only students of UI, but also students of UTokyo.”, “I am satisfied with my practical English ability through the program.”, “Although it was held online, I learned a lot and improved myself through the program.” etc.

Chulalongkorn University Summer Program ①

1. Program Objectives/Contents

The theme of this program is “Arts Chula Summer Program in Thai Language and Culture (Online)”

- Thai language/practice
- Lectures on Thai culture (Thailand-Japan Relationship, and the history of Thai democratization)
- Virtual tours of historical sites
- Group works
- Final presentations on the last day

2. Eligibility criteria

- Undergraduate and graduate students
- Number of students accepted: approx. 20 (CU students will participate in the program partially)
- Students who have ability to listen to lectures in English and join a group discussion in English
- Students who are interested in long-term study abroad, learning English and cross-cultural understanding

3. Cost • Scholarship

- (Details will be confirmed later) THB 10,000 (approx. JPY 35,000) ✕It may increase depending on the number of the participant.
- Students accepted into one of the online programs may apply for “Go Global Scholarships for Online Course Programs offered by Overseas Institutions” (Details will be announced around late May – June.)



4. From the coordinator

- Orientation: Held online on Tuesday, August 16th for about an hour or two. All students who pass the selection processes are required to attend
- Feedback from AY2021 participants: Overall satisfaction rate is 9.1 out of 10! “Proactive interaction with Thai students was meaningful.”, “This program is useful for not only learning about Thailand, but also for thinking about Asia.”, “The contents were designed not to feel bored and varied such as Thai culture, Thai cuisine, Thai dance.”

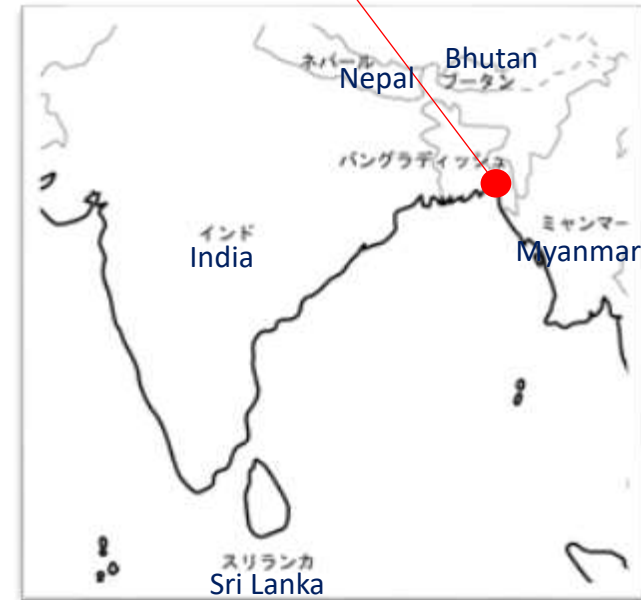
Asian University for Women (AUW) Online Summer Program①

(August 1 – 8, 2022)

1. Overview

- Think about gender and society together with the students of AUW.

- Learn about gender studies and visual ethnography in lectures and develop practical skills at film-making in hands-on workshops.
- Shoot a film outside the classroom after plenary lectures and workshops.

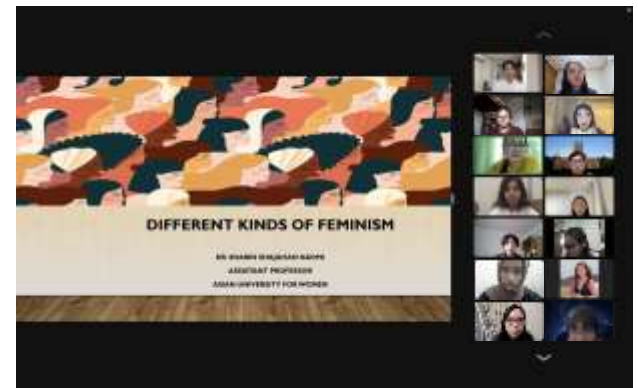
2. Eligibility

- Undergraduate students who have submitted a Go Global Statement and had it approved.
- Undergraduate students with an intermediate level of English (CEFR B1 –B2)
- Any year, major, and gender are welcome!
- No expert knowledge of gender studies and visual ethnography required!

Asian University for Women (AUW) Online Summer Program②

(August 1 – 8, 2022)

- Need to pay a program fee (JPY 5,000)
- Need to participation in an orientation session (scheduled in mid- or late-July)
- Need to bring a digital device equipped with a video camera
- Will receive a certificate of completion
- Can interact with students from diverse backgrounds (Bangladesh, India, Bhutan, Afghanistan, etc.)
- Can familiarize yourself with visual ethnography
