This is to inform you that the special measures regarding your term of residence at International Lodge (Komaba and Kashiwa) and International Hall of Residence (Toshima, Oiwake and Mitaka) will end on November 30, 2022 due to the current situation that international students newly coming to Japan for a long-term stay are allowed to enter Japan based on the new border measures (28) released on May 20, 2022 and the new border measures (29) released on May 26, 2022.

1. As long as you are enrolled in UTokyo and do not take a leave of absence, you are required to move in your room **by no later than November 30, 2022**. Rooms will need to be cancelled if you cannot move in within the given time frame. If you take a leave of absence, you are not eligible to move-in and you are required to cancel your room offer. If you are to cancel your assigned room, please email both the office in charge of each accommodation listed in **【Contact】** below and your affiliated faculty/department office.
2. Accommodation fees will not be charged until your actual move-in date/month.
 - International Lodges
 - Accommodation fees will be prorated

Note: The common service fees at the International Lodges will be charged on a monthly basis and will not be prorated.
 - Mitaka International Hall of Residence
 - Rent will be charged on a monthly basis.

Note: Room reparation fee (60,000 JPY) will be charged regardless of actual residence period.
 - Toshima and Oiwake International Hall of Residence
 - Rent will be charged on a monthly basis.
3. There will be no change in the original final date of your term of residence.

Please keep us updated and let us know of your expected date of arrival once your visa is issued. Be sure to include your name, application number, the name of the UTokyo accommodation that you are to stay and your room number when contacting for our convenience.
