You are assigned to one of the off-campus apartment near the campus, which is random. Most of the apartments are very old, so you might experience power outage. 2-3 persons share the apartment with shared bathroom.

Since winter is way too long, be sure that you have enough clothes to bundle up. Not many supermarkets or restaurants exist near the apartment so it might be better to order grocery or something online.

Almost everyone opens an account at Bank of America. It is better to have physical card all the time as some restaurants do not accept cash. Apple pay is quite common. Do not forget to tip them (usually 18%).

■治安、医療関係事情、心身の健康管理で気をつけたこと等、危機管理/Aspects of risk and safety management, local health care system, and any actions taken to maintain your health:

I did not feel dangerous, but there were 2-3 gunshots near the campus. You can use campus shuttle or door-to-door services at late night. Yale health covers almost everything and you can use counseling services if you need someone to talk.
