## THINGS TO CONFIRM BEFORE TRAVELING TO THE COUNTRIES/AREAS DESIGNATED AS LEVEL 2 OR LEVEL 3 OF TRAVEL ADVICE AND WARNING ON INFECTIOUS DISEASES DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

- (1) I understand the latest information on the latest infection status in the host institution's country/area.
- (2) I understand and will follow the border measures of the host institution's country/area such as COVID-19 test, submitting an inspection certificate, requirement for self-quarantine and others.
- (3) I understand the rules for preventing infection such as wearing masks in the host institution's country/area.
- (4) I understand actions to be taken and have contact information (as follows) if I am suspected of COVID-19 infection, designated as a close contact person or test positive for COVID-19 in the host institution's country/area.
  - ① Available assistance: International students support section at the partner universities or Japan Educational Exchanges and Services (JEES) "Futai Kaigaku" School Insurance Desk and the Overseas Student Safety Management Assistance (OSSMA) help line.
  - ② Available COVID-19 test facilities: same as above.
  - ③ Medical institutions: same as above.
- (5) I am aware of various possible risks during the global uncertainty due to COVID-19 (e.g. risk of restriction on medical and university support, risk of not being able to move freely, etc.).
- (6) I understand there is a possibility that rescuers (e.g. my family or/and UTokyo affiliate) may not be able to enter the host institution's country/area immediately or at all due to its border restrictions in the event of accidents or other emergencies.
- (7) I understand Japan's latest border measures for departure and arrival, and they are subject to change and may affect my post-program plans.
- (8) I understand the actions to be taken in the event of an epidemic of (resurgence of) COVID-19 in the host institution's country/area during my future travel.
- (9) I will respond and cooperate promptly if UTokyo or/and the host institution request(s) me to submit any reports (including my health information) during and after the program.
