- (1) I understand the latest information on the latest infection status in the host institution's country/area.
- (2) I understand and will follow the border measures of the host institution's country/area such as COVID-19 test, submitting an inspection certificate, requirement for self-quarantine and others.
- (3) I understand the rules for preventing infection such as wearing masks in the host institution's country/area.
- (4) I understand actions to be taken and have contact information (as follows) if I am suspected of COVID-19 infection, designated as a close contact person or test positive for COVID-19 in the host institution's country/area.
