

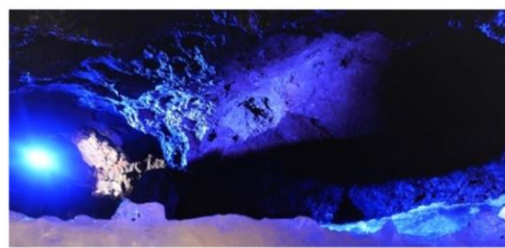
2023 <KIO> Japanese Culture Tour
