You need a proof of health insurance coverage from a German statutory health insurer or - if you are already insured in your home country – an exemption certificate from a German statutory health insurer for your enrolment. A German statutory health insurance costs

approx. 120 EUR per month.

**Visa Requirements** 

Please inform yourself in your home country about visa conditions for your entry to Germany. At the latest 90 days after arrival in Germany, a residence permit must be applied for.

**Semester Fee** 

The UoC does not charge any tuition fees. However, all students (whether they come to Cologne or study remotely) must pay a social contribution fee of around 320 EUR per semester. This fee also includes a ticket for public transportation (busses & rail) in North Rhine-Westphalia.
