<b>Application Procedures</b>	<p>Communication will be via Line (UT-FGL). Please join Line group after applying for program to receive important updates. Introduce self on Line group and update your name to how you would like to be called in Romaji during the program.</p>
<b>Payment due</b>	<p>Non-refundable deposit of \$350 is due December 15th, 2023. The remaining \$3,600 is due January 12, 2024.</p> <p>Tuition after Deposit in JPY: Determined on Dec 15 yen conversion date. Will convert total USD amount due on conversion date, minus any payments made including yen deposit. Student will then be invoiced for final amount due.</p> <p>If tuition and/or optional tour payment is made before Dec 15: Tuition and Optional Tour payments made before Dec 15 will be calculated at 150 yen to 1 US dollar. After Dec 15, student will be reimbursed the difference if the yen is stronger than 150 yen to 1 USD, and the student will be invoiced if the yen weakens higher than 150 on Dec 15.</p>
<b>Cancel policy</b>	<p>There is a non-refundable deposit of \$350 for each participant. However, the remainder can be refunded up to 45 days before the start of the program. If student is a non-Japanese national and fails to secure a visa, deposit will be refunded if request is made 14 days or more before program start. Also, if program is cancelled for any reason, all deposits will be refunded.</p>

<b>Important notes related to COVID-19, if any</b>	<p>Testing kits will be made available for any students that suspect they may have covid-19 related symptoms. Those students that test positive will quarantine in their room for five days and can only leave quarantine if they are no longer exhibiting symptoms. If they have roommates the roommate will be temporarily relocated. It is requested that when they leave their room they wear a mask and disinfect with sanitizer any surfaces they touch that is shared with others, and maintain two meters of distance when around others. This is in accordance with California OSHA recommendations. They can continue their studies during quarantine, as all lectures will be recorded on video.</p>
