Given that I have a 6-month free period before working full-time, I want to use this time to experience different cultures.

I was supposed to graduate in September 2022. However, the company I plan to work at only accepts new employees to join from April. Hence, I decided to delay my graduation for six more months and go on exchange. This is also an involuntary choice since I initially applied for exchange in 2020 autumn semester, but as canceled due to COVID.

■留学中の学習・研究の概要/Overview of the study/research during study abroad:

Most classes here have two lectures per week. Hence, it would require good time management skills

to meet all the deadlines. You have to register at least 12 credits to keep your legal visa status.

I go to gym trainings regularly and visit museums nearby.

On weekends, I normally work on the homework assignments. The study abroad office sometimes also organize one-day visits to places nearby. I used fall break and thanksgiving break to visit my highschool friends in other East Coast cities.

■設備/Facilities:

The libraries and gyms are very nice.

■サポート体制/Support for students:

The study abroad office is very supportive. You can reach out to them easily. It is also easy to make friends with other exchange students.

プログラム期間中の生活について/About life during the program

■宿泊先の種類/Type of accommodation:

Rented apartments, etc., The university signed lease with the apartment office, so we technically lived in the accommodation provided by the university.

■宿泊先の様子、どのように見つけたか/Environment around the accommodation and how did you find it:

We live in a 4-bedroom suite with 2 shared bathrooms and 1 shared kitchen, living room. The facility is new and only 2-minute walk to the campus.

■気候、大学周辺の様子、交通機関、食事等/Climate, environment around the institution, transportation, food, etc.:

There are some chain restaurants, dining cars around the campus. The cafeteria on campus costs around 11 dollars per meal. The quality of food in general is not very good. For transportation, you can take free city bus and shuttle bus to downtown and train station. However, they may not always come on time.

■お金の管理方法、現地の通貨事情/Management of money and situation about local economy:

There is a bank 1-minute walk away from the apartment. I opened a VISA saving account there without extra charge. It is relatively easy to open bank accounts in America. If you do not wish to, you should bring a VISA instead of JCB debit card from Japan, since most places here take VISA.

■治安、医療関係事情、心身の健康管理で気をつけたこと等、危機管理/Aspects of risk and safety management, local health care system, and any actions taken to maintain your health:

I do not walk outside the campus by myself. If I need to visit local supermarket for grocery, I would go together with another person. Robbery with weapon happens often here.

The procedure was pretty smooth, since the university study abroad office would reach out to you once you are nominated. If you have any problem, you can email the assistant for help.

I applied for J1 visa. The procedure took around 3 weeks. It would be better to register the visa appointment earlier.

The university required people to get 2 additional vaccine shots and blood test to live in the dorm.

Just follow the guidelines from both universities.

I completed first draft of my thesis before going on exchange, but decided to submit it when I returned.
