Program contents/outline	<p>English for Global Communication is a 4-week summer programme which is designed for undergraduate students from global universities. It consists of tuition at the University of Warwick with a focus on the development of English language and intercultural skills. It is designed to equip students with the skills, strategies and competencies that are needed in today's globally connected world. The programme also includes cultural trips to places such as London, Oxford, Warwick and Stratford Upon Avon, as well as homestay with a local family with half-board on weekdays and full board at weekends, local transportation ticket, all included within the quoted price. There will be a 3 day weekend given on the third weekend of the programme to allow for students to travel, and to coincide with the bank holiday Monday on the 26th August.</p>

English for Global Communication (EGC) – 4 week

Arrival: 4th August

Course dates: Monday 5th August to Friday 30th August 2024

The University of Warwick's English for Global Communication (EGC) Programme is designed for undergraduate students from global universities. It consists of tuition at the University of Warwick with a focus on the development of English language and intercultural skills. It is designed to equip students with the skills, strategies and competencies that are needed in today's globally connected world.

The programme provides an opportunity to meet with students of different nationalities from other universities, experience academic and campus life at one of the top global universities and enjoy a programme of social events and cultural visits.



Programme Aims

The programme is designed primarily for undergraduate students and has several aims:

- To prepare participants to communicate in English in today's culturally diverse communities.
- To improve participants' competency and confidence in using English in a range of social and professional contexts, both inside and outside of the classroom.
- To increase participants' sensitivity to cultural difference in communication and strategies for successfully negotiating such difference.
- To develop participants' functional ability in the four skill areas (reading, writing, listening and speaking), and in particular, their fluency and accuracy in spoken interactions.
- To help participants become autonomous language learners.
- To enhance participants' ability to engage in discussion and debate.
- To improve participants' critical thinking skills.
- To develop participants' presentation skills.
- To provide participants' with a 'toolkit' of strategies for coping with the challenges of authentic communication.

Programme Fee: £2,950 per person

The tuition fee includes:

- Delivery of the 4-week programme according to the outline above.
- Accommodation - Participants stay in homestay accommodation with host families who are located a short bus ride from campus.
- Airport collection on arrival (accompanied) and drop-off at the end of the programme, if travelling as a group.
- Cultural trips to places such as Warwick Castle, Stratford Upon Avon, London and/or Oxford.
- Intercultural social events such as a pub quiz, sports day and/or games night.
- University registration which gives physical access to the library and IT facilities.
- A welcome lunch on the first day and a farewell lunch on the final day of the programme with Faculty staff.
- Warwick certificate of completion and group photograph.

The programme fees do not include:

- the cost of flights or travel/health insurance for participants.
- visa costs.

Important to note:

- Student visas maybe required to study in the UK, but this will be dependent on the country of origin. Visas are the participants responsibility to organise, and invitation letters can be organised and sent to participants prior to applying for a visa.
- Participants are expected to arrange their own appropriate travel insurance covering health, and loss of belongings.
