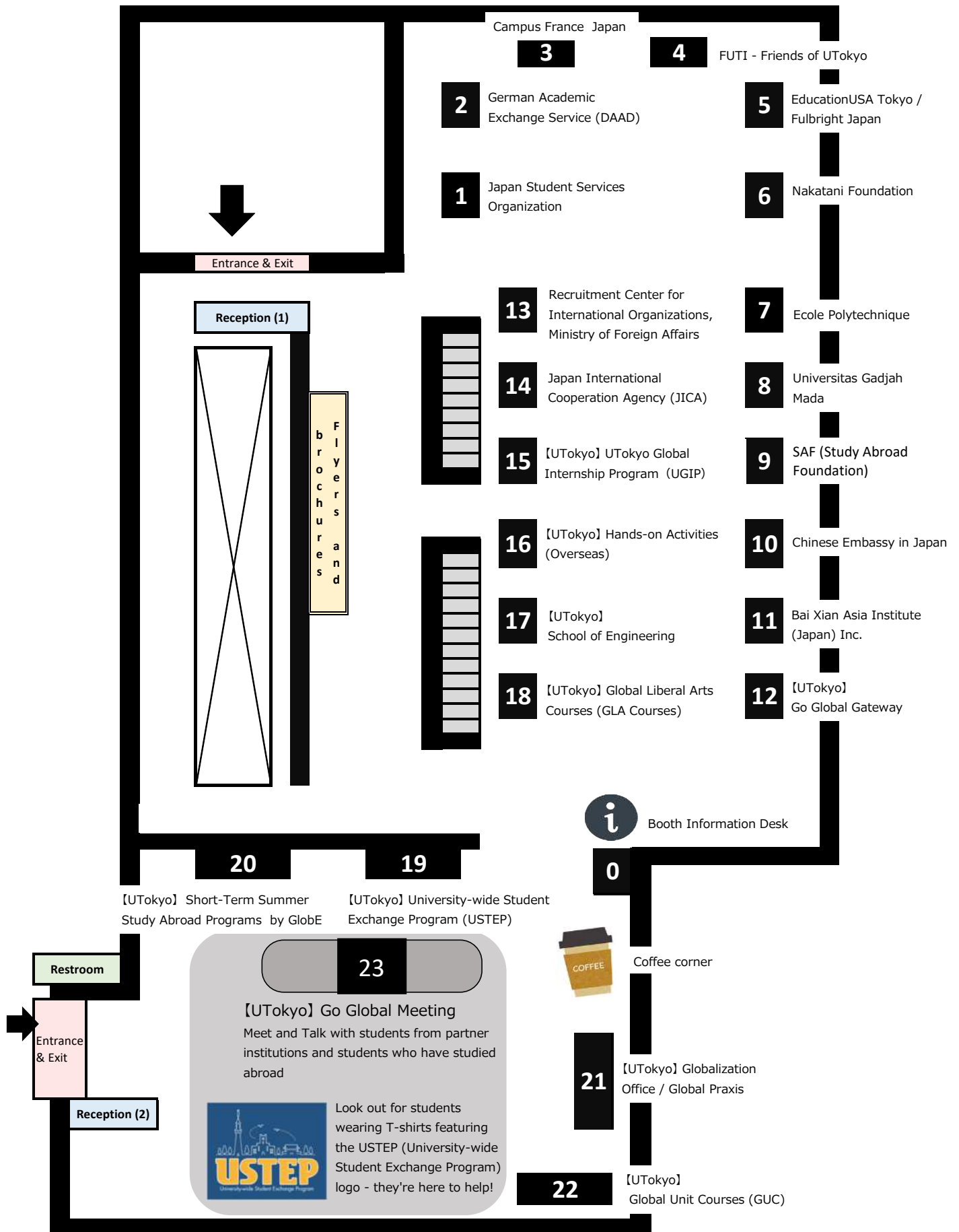

This scholarship program was established by a Hong Kong businessman who is an alumnus of the University of Tokyo, based on his vision of fostering the next generation of Asian leaders by promoting youth exchange, especially between Japan and China. 12,500 USD will be granted for one year of exchange study at Beijing, Tsinghua, Shanghai Jiao Tong, Chinese University of Hong Kong, or Hong Kong University of Science and Technology. The scholarship also provides support for long-lasting exchanges among fellow scholarship recipients (not only Japanese but also international students from overseas to Japan) after their study abroad.
