CALL FOR STUDENTS

Dear U7+ University Partners,

We are pleased to announce that the 2024 Student Forum is quickly approaching, and we are ready to accept your student delegates. Please read on for more details about the theme and purpose of the Forum this year, and for information on when and how to submit the names of your nominated students.

What is the Student Forum?

In previous years, the U7+ Student Forum has successfully challenged students from diverse academic backgrounds to come together, consider, and discuss issues related to intergenerational justice and climate change. Feedback from participants has been positive.

Since 2023 the Forum has been planned by École Polytechnique in collaboration with the U7+ Alliance as well as the Student and Alumni Network.

The theme for the 2024 Forum is *How can universities best prepare students for the AI era /How do we maximize its benefits and mitigate its risks*? The forum will be held virtually, over Zoom.

Students who participate in this forum will be immersed in a two-week learning experience where they are grouped with delegates from other U7+ universities around the world. The forum will have elements of both listening and active participation, with exciting panels, workshops, and discussion groups throughout the month.

Who should participate?

We welcome each U7+ University to send up to four delegates. Students must be currently enrolled in the university to participate, at either the Bachelor's, Master's, or PhD level of study. We encourage universities to send students from all academic backgrounds. Although not mandatory, we request that you seek to send students from more than one specialization and avoid selecting all four delegates from the same program of study.

It is not necessary for students to be experts in the topic of AI and Education. Student delegates should be interested in the topic, willing to listen and learn, and willing to participate in group discussions based on presentations or discussion prompts. A basic working proficiency in English is required as all events and group work will occur in English.

In the past, some universities have chosen to approach students individually based on their research related to the forum topic. Other universities have chosen to distribute information about the Forum to a larger group of students and accept applications before selecting the delegates. It is the choice of each university to decide how to select their delegates.
