

# <u>Visiting International Students Program (VISP)</u>

### Fall/Academic Year 2025 - 2026 Factsheet



Johns Hopkins University welcomes applications from undergraduate international and exchange students interested in attending Johns Hopkins for a semester or academic year as study abroad (non-degree) students. # **Program Overview**

#### Eligibility

- You must be at least 18 years of age
- You must be registered in a degree program at your home university
- You must be nominated by your home institution
- Minimum GPA of 3.0 or the equivalent
- English Language Proficiency (completed no more than 2 years prior to the visa application process)
  - Minimum of 100 total for the Internet-based TOEFL (iBT) with preferred subscores of 26 (Reading), 26 (Listening), 22 (Writing), and 25 (Speaking)
  - A score of 7.0 or higher on each band of the IELTS
  - A composite score of 120 or higher is expected for the DET with preferred sub-scores of 125 (Literacy), 120 (Conversation), 135 (Comprehension), and 105 (Production)
  - C1 Advanced or C2 Proficiency expected with a Cambridge English score of 185 or higher
  - \*\*If no English language assessment, students will need to participate in an English language conversation as part of their application

Visas	<ul> <li>Visiting International and Exchange Students are admitted to Hopkins on J-1 Visas. Once you have completed your online application and received your admissions letter, you will receive instructions to initiate your J-1 Visa (DS-2019) process.</li> <li>Your DS-2019 dates correspond to the first and last day of classes</li> <li>There is a 30-day grace period at the beginning and end of the exchange during which you can enter or remain in the U.S. for non-academic purposes</li> </ul>
Health Insurance	VISP students are <b>required</b> to enroll in JHU health insurance
