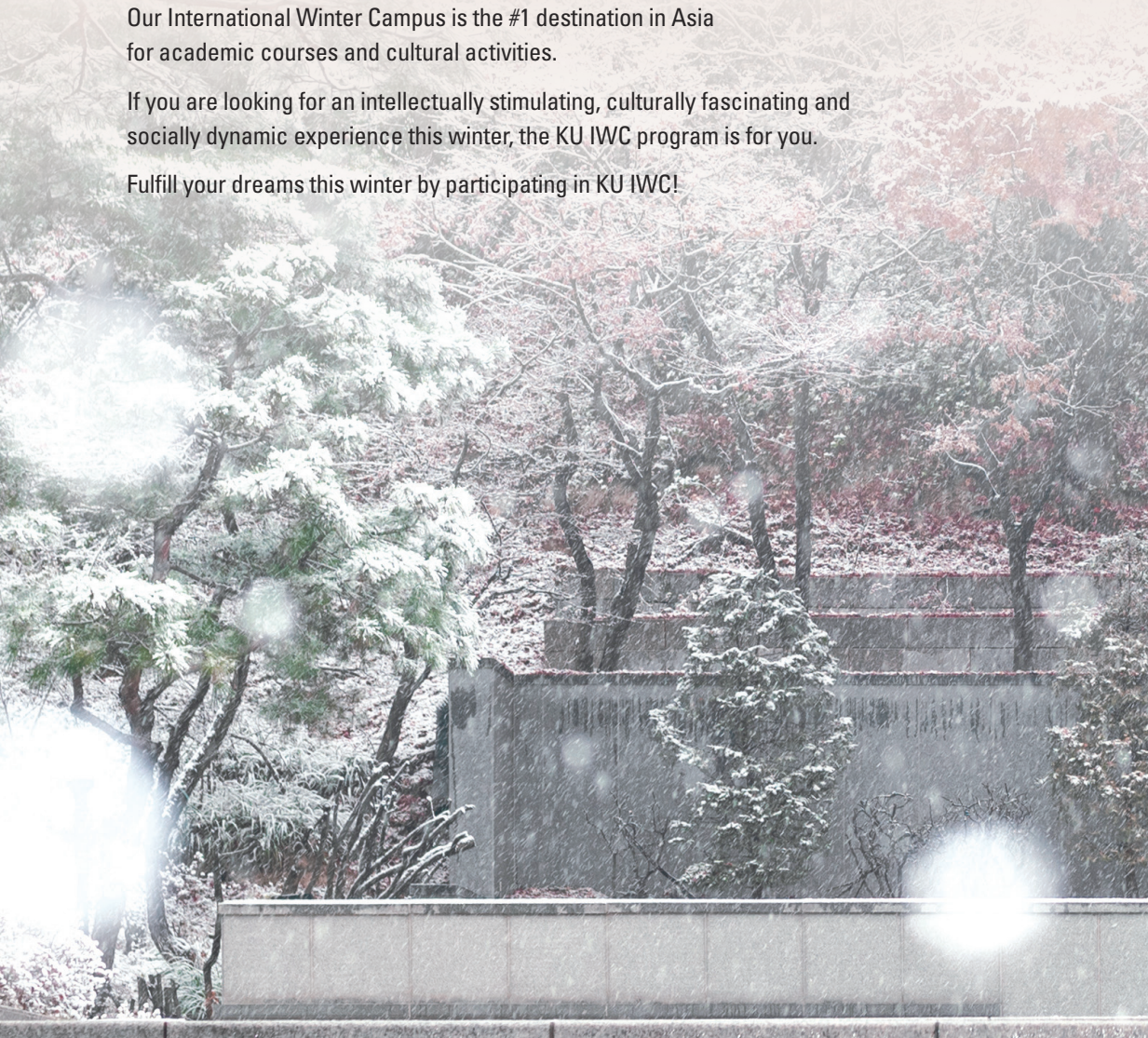

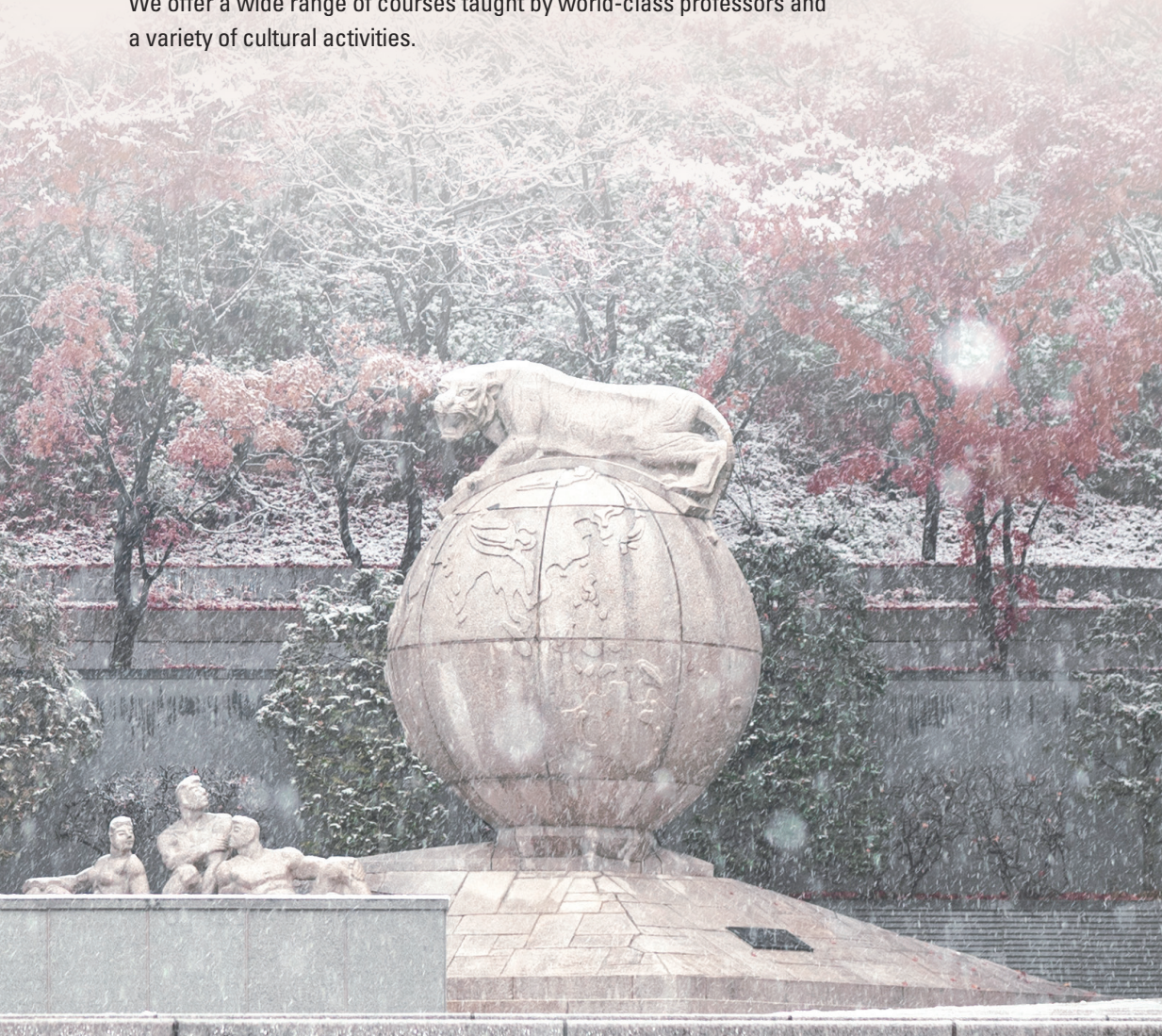




## Korea University International Winter Campus

### ❖ Eligibility

- Students currently enrolled in an accredited college/university
- Academically motivated high school student (age 18+ in Year 12) or high school graduates

### ❖ Required Documents

- Copy of Academic Transcript
- Copy of Passport
- Proof of Health Insurance  
(only for students enrolled in in-person courses)
- Consent Letter signed by a legal guardian  
(only for pre-college students)

### ❖ Application Procedures

1. Complete the online application form at [winter2.korea.ac.kr](http://winter2.korea.ac.kr).  
(course selection to be completed through the online application form)
2. Pay the application fee of KRW 100,000  
(non-refundable)
3. Send the required documents to [kuwinter@korea.ac.kr](mailto:kuwinter@korea.ac.kr)
4. Receive the 'Letter of Acceptance'
5. Pay the tuition and all remaining fees
