Registration Steps

1. Complete the Berkeley Summer Sessions application

- a. Applicants must login or create an account to access the application.
- b. Submit documentation for the **English Proficiency Requirement** via the application unless exempt.
- c. There is a \$25 non-refundable application fee.
- d. For any questions or issues with the application, please contact summer@berkeley.edu

2. Establish CalNet ID and access CalCentral

- a. After completing the application, applicants will receive email instructions with their Student ID number within 2-3 days.
- a. For CalNet ID support, students may contact calnet2-stephelp@berkeley.edu.

3. Enroll in Classes via Calcentral

a. International students traveling on a F-1 student visa must be enrolled full-time.

4. Submit I-20 Request via the International Student Services (ISS) Portal

- a. International students will have a CalCentral task item with a link to the I-20 request form.
- b. For any visa, I-20, or immigration questions, please contact visiting-intl@berkelev.edu.

5. Pay Total Balance

a. Self-paying visiting students (not sponsored by their university) must pay the tuition and fees within 7 days of enrollment; otherwise, they will be dropped from all classes for non-payment.

6. Apply for Housing

a. A variety of housing options are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

7. Check Berkeley Email Account REGULARLY

a. All communications from Berkeley will be sent to the student's Berkeley email account, including class changes, enrollment updates, finances, I-20 information and action items, etc.

How Students Affiliate Themselves

Students must affiliate themselves with your institution or organization in the Summer Sessions application; otherwise, they will not be eligible for any affiliate benefits, including early enrollment.
