- Kindly note that UTokyo and IMS cannot assume responsibility for any late issuance of visa due to insufficient/incorrect documents or late submission of the visa application.
- Students are not allowed to work in Japan on this visa.
- The maximum number of days allowed for a student's personal travel before and/or after the program on this visa shall be around 1 week in total.
- UTokyo GUC will provide support for Temporary Visitor visa only. Any support for visas other than the Temporary Visitor visa will not be provided.
