

Regarding the All-Gender Residential Area at the Mejirodai International Village

1. Overview of the Shared Type Rooms at the Mejirodai International Village

Student rooms at the Mejirodai International Village (hereinafter referred to as the “Mejirodai Village”) are mostly the shared type rooms with the following key features:

- In-Room Facilities: wash basin, refrigerator, air conditioner, desk and chair, bed (with mattress), lighting, curtain, laundry pole
- Shared Facilities: kitchen (one per residential block), living/dining space, showers (4-5 shower booths per residential block), toilets (1 restroom per elevator hall with 3-5 private units), laundry rooms (1 per elevator hall with 2 washing machines and 2 dryers)

Each room is designed as a single private room for students, around 20 of which are to form a “shared block” where residents are to share water-related facilities such as kitchens, showers and toilets in addition to the living/dining spaces. Residents are expected to cooperate in the cleaning and managing of the communal facilities within the shared blocks. If any issues or uncertainties arise in daily life, residents are encouraged to initiatively consult the resident assistants living on the same floor or the in-house advisors residing in the North Building of the Mejirodai Village.

2. Overview of the All-Gender Residential Area in the Mejirodai International Village

While there are separate male and female floors for the shared type rooms at the Mejirodai International Village, the All-Gender Residential Area offers an all inclusive space for anyone to live together regardless of their gender and gender identity.

The all-gender residential area of Mejirodai Village is located on the 6th floor of the Linear Building. Like other share blocks, it includes communal facilities such as a kitchen, living and dining space, and showers. In addition, shared toilets and laundry rooms are installed in the elevator halls on both sides of each block.

Room balconies in the All-Gender Residential Area are all separated by partition walls from adjacent rooms out of for respect for the privacy of the occupants.

Access to the All-Gender Residential Area is limited solely to the residents living within that section where they are specially allowed to move freely between blocks within the same all-gender area.

- ※ Residents of the female and male floors are not allowed to move between blocks, even if they do live on the same floor.

3. Details of the Shared Facilities in the All-Gender Residential Area

The following facilities are to be used communally among the residents residing in the All-Gender Residential Area.

Please check the important points below which you need to be mindful about when using the shared facilities.

Shared Facility	Overview	Remarks
Living, Kitchen, Dining Space	Like other share blocks, this space is where residents cook, dine, and relax. It also serves as a place for interaction and communication among residents. Be sure to collect all personal belongings and dispose of any trash after each use to keep the space pleasant for everyone.	
Showers	There are 4-5 unit-shower booths per block, which residents are to use individually by locking the door from the inside. Each shower booth is equipped with an emergency button for urgent contact. Please check its location in advance for safety.	
Toilets	There are 3-5 shared toilet booths in the elevator hall on both sides of the block, which residents are to use individually by locking the door from the inside. Each toilet booth has an emergency button for urgent contact, so please check its location beforehand. For security measures, surveillance cameras are installed at the handwashing areas inside the restrooms, and the outer doors leading to the hallway have partial glass panels to enhance visibility.	
Laundry	There are two washing machines and two dryers in the elevator hall on both sides of the block (paid use). After doing your laundry, please promptly remove your items to ensure that everyone can use the facilities smoothly and considerately.	

4. Important Notes for Application

Please ensure that you fully understand the characteristics of the shared facilities and the purpose of introducing the All-Gender Common before applying. In addition, residents are required to take part in the "Training to Deepen D&I Understanding at the University of Tokyo" (tentative title).
