



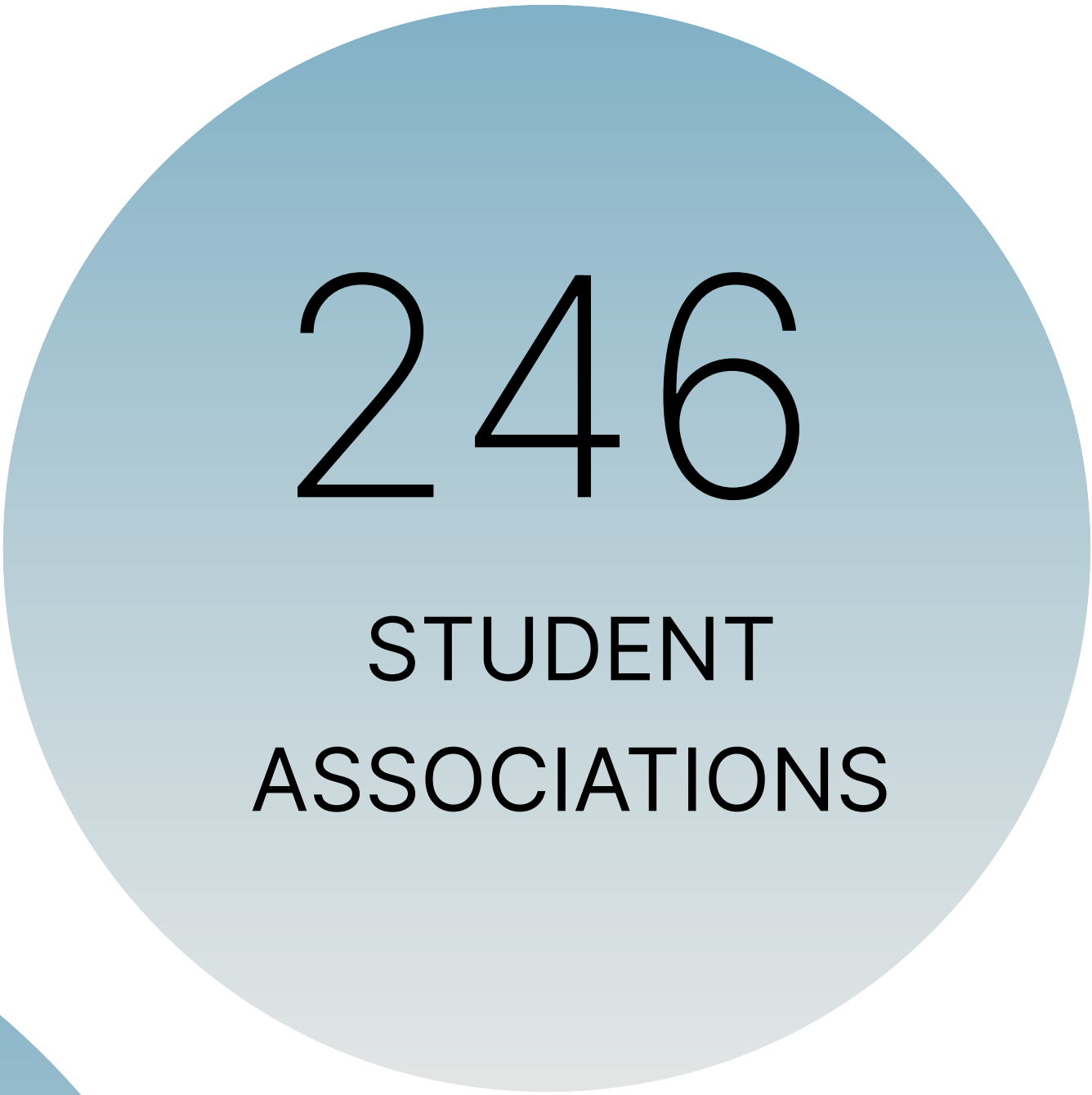
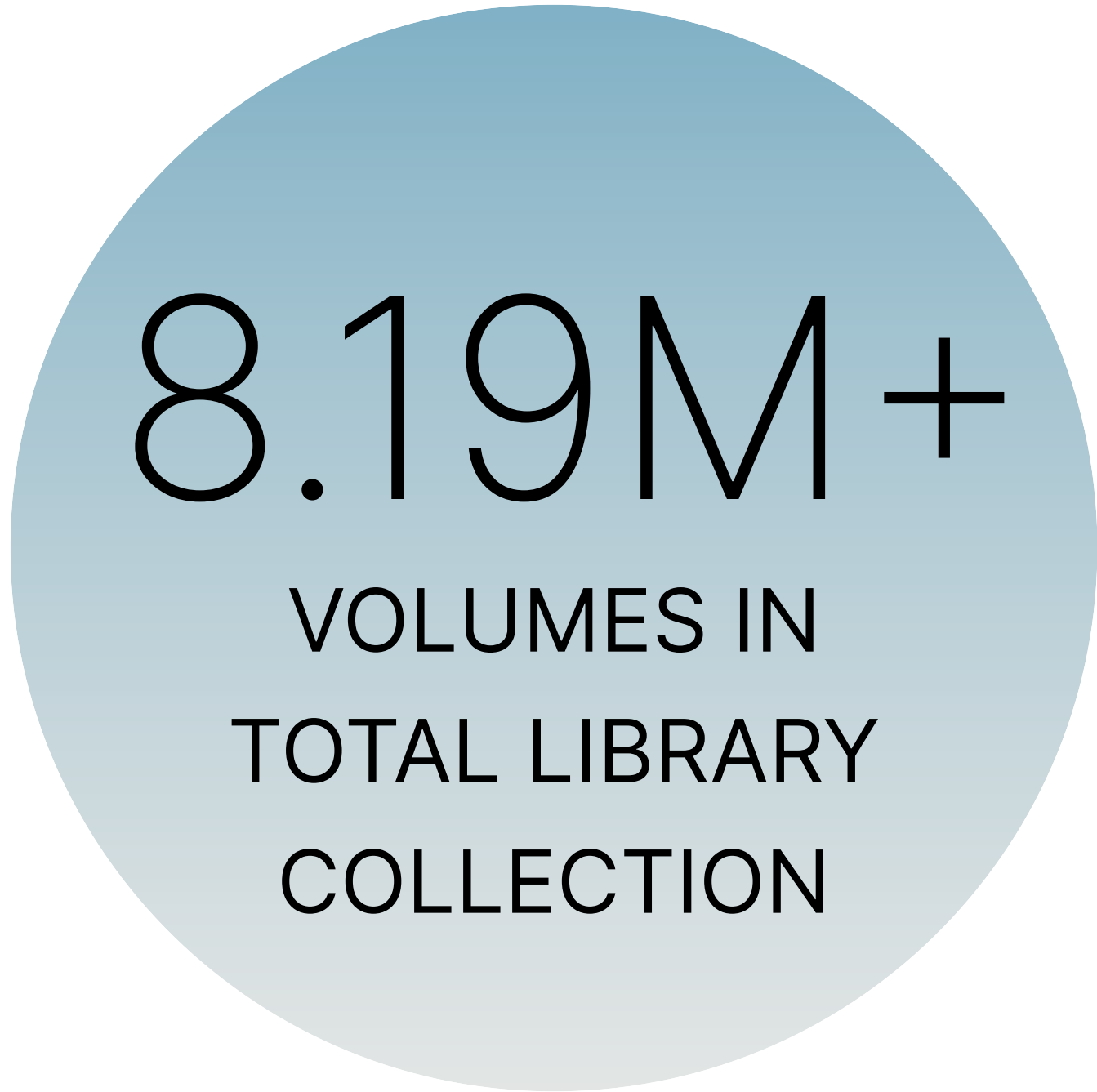

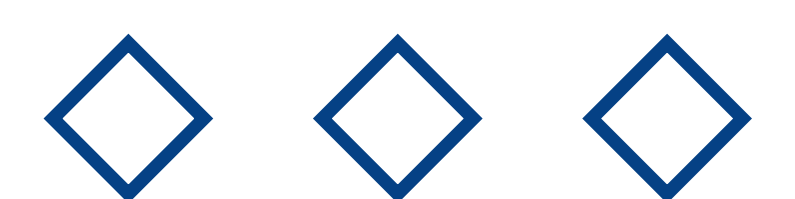

Exchange Programs

Undergraduate Program

- Students are affiliated to one of undergraduate faculties or schools and take undergraduate-level courses with Zhejiang University students.
- Students admitted in this program with advanced level of Chinese language (e.g. HSK 5 or above) could also take courses on Chinese language and courses on Survey of China (both courses include 48 teaching hours per semester).

Graduate Program

- Students are affiliated to one of graduate schools and take graduate-level courses with Zhejiang University students.
- Students admitted in this program could also take courses on Chinese language (32 teaching hours per semester) and courses on Survey of China (48 teaching hours per semester).

Chinese Language Program

- ZJU offers intensive courses on Chinese language and culture at different levels for international students. Students are to be placed in classes that suit them the best by taking a class placement test. The intensive Chinese language and culture program includes courses of reading, listening, practical conversation and writing. Students could take no more than 2 elective courses on Chinese society and culture per semester.
- This is a non-credit program. A Certificate of Completion will be issued upon successful completion of the program.

Nomination and Application Deadline	Campuses located in Hangzhou: May 10, 2026 Haining Campus (ZJUI and ZIBS): April 10, 2026
Nomination Link	Nomination link will be sent to home university coordinators via email.
Application Portal	Applicants for the Undergraduate and Graduate Programs should apply after March 27, 2026, while applicants for the Chinese Language Program should apply after April 6, 2026. Applications must be submitted through the application system: https://intlstudent.zju.edu.cn
Eligibility	1. Be enrolled as a full-time student at your home university throughout the entire duration of your exchange at ZJU 2. Be officially nominated by your home university 3. Demonstrate excellent academic performance 4. Provide official proof of the required language proficiency (Applicants from non-English-speaking backgrounds) 5. Commit to returning to your home university upon completion of the exchange program at ZJU 6. Hold non-Chinese citizenship (Students with Chinese citizenship are not eligible to apply)
Language Requirements	1. For Chinese-taught Undergraduate/Graduate Courses Applicants must have HSK certificate, generally with a score over 180 in HSK 5. 2. For English-taught Undergraduate/Graduate Courses Applicants from non-English-speaking backgrounds are required to provide an IELTS score of 6.5, a TOEFL iBT score of 88, or a CEFR B2 level certification. Alternatively, an official English proficiency certificate issued by the applicant’s home university (e.g., a language proficiency letter or medium-of-instruction statement) is also acceptable. IELTS retakes and TOEFL MyBest score are accepted.
Application Procedure	1. Home University Online Nomination: The nomination link will be sent to the home university coordinators. (For internal use by partners only) 2. Student Online Application: All application materials must be uploaded to the application system, including: • A passport valid for at least six months after the program end date; • Latest official English academic transcripts; • A valid language proficiency certificate. Application Note: Under ‘Source of Funding’, please choose ‘University-level Exchange Student’. No application fee is required. 3. Admission Result: Admission Notice can be downloaded from the Online Application System around early July, 2026. Download link of the electronic Confirmation Form for Study in China /Information Form for Foreign Students' Short-term Visit (for visa) will be sent to the permanent email address filled in the application system by the applicant. Admission result timelines may differ among different exchange programs.

Academic Calendar

The academic calendar for the 2026–27 Fall/Winter semester has not yet been officially released. Based on last year’s schedule, the semester is expected to run approximately from September 2026 to January 2027.
The registration date should be strictly in accordance with the date specified in the admission letter.

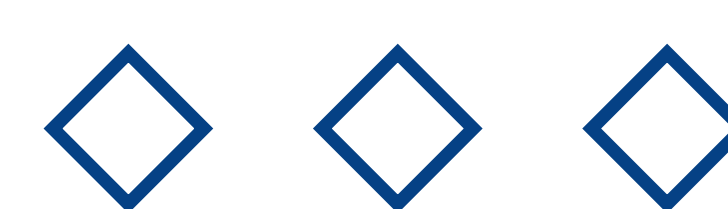


Course Selection

1. Course selection will begin in the first week after the semester starts.
2. Students based at campuses in Hangzhou can take courses across different colleges or departments.
3. The ZJUI and ZIBS are located at the Haining Campus (conveniently situated between Shanghai and Hangzhou). Haining Campus utilizes a separate course selection system from those of Zijingang and Yuquan Campuses. Students are not allowed to cross-register for courses between Haining Campus and campuses located in Hangzhou.



Academic Information



Credit System

1. Full-degree undergraduate students at ZJU are required to get a minimum of 15 credits per semester and a total of 169 credits during their 4-5 years study program. Full-degree graduate students at ZJU are required to get a total of 26 credits during their 2-2.5 years study program.
2. 1 credit at ZJU is equivalent to 16 teaching hours at ZJU.
3. We do not have any credit requirements for exchange students.

Transcript

Transcript will be sent to coordinator via email at the beginning of subsequent semester.

Accommodation

1. Students will book and pay for accommodation before arrival, after receiving the reservation link via email.
2. Students are allowed to check in maximum 3 days prior to the registration date.

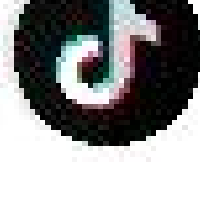

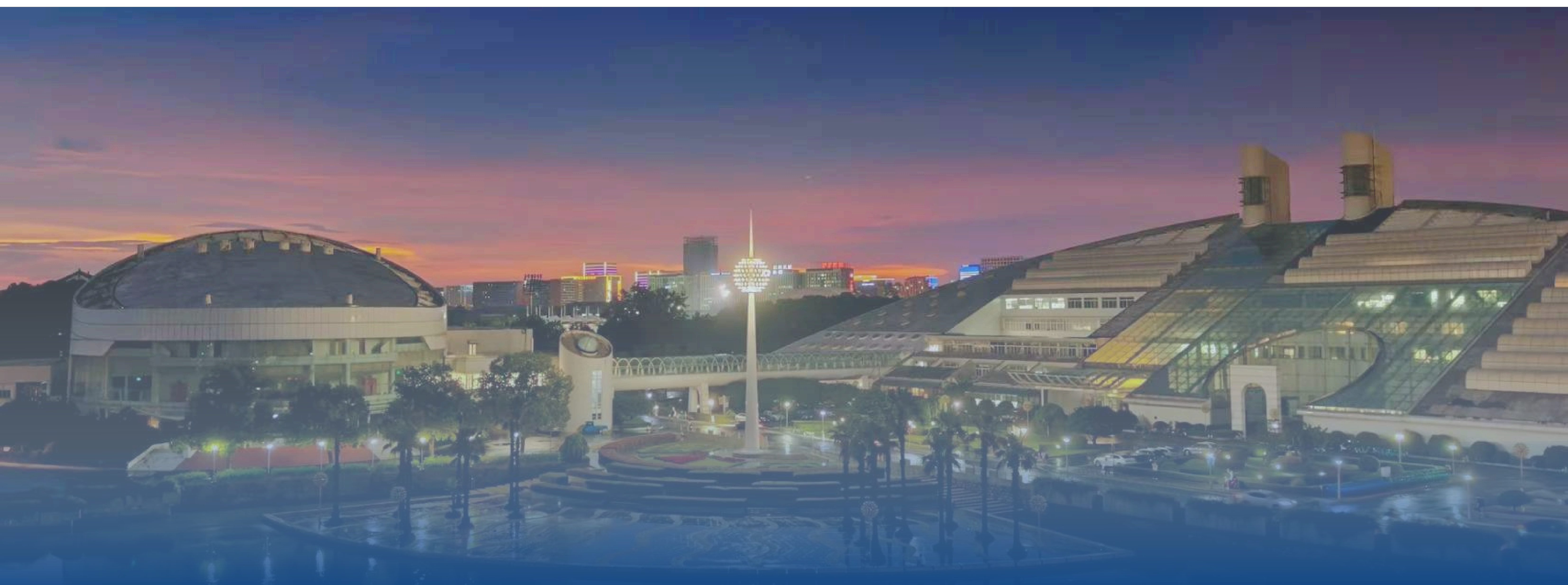
