Exchange Categories

Fudan provides three different exchange programs. Students must choose ONLY ONE of them:

1.Chinese Language Program (taking Chinese Language courses at ICES ONLY)

2.General Advanced Program (taking undergraduate-level courses)

In general, General Advanced Program students CAN NOT take Chinese Language courses at ICES. Limited Chinese Language courses at ICES and non-credit Chinese language training classes might be available in this program, but there is NO guarantee that they will be available every semester. Registered Chinese Language courses at ICES will appear on your official transcript, but non-credit Chinese language training classes will NOT.

Undergraduate-level courses in medicine and other restricted programs are not available.

Deadlines for Nomination and Application

***Important Note:**

- 1.If your nominee quit the exchange program AFTER registration at Fudan University, this nominee counts for one semester place and there will be no replacement.
- 2.If your nominated students want to extend their study at Fudan for one more semester, please renominate them in the next round of nomination again. International students need to leave mainland China and apply for new student visa for the new program.

Check List for Application

(digital documents needed to be uploaded in the application system, NO hardcopies required)

- Photocopy of valid Passport (information page, at least 6 months period of validity)
- ID photo
- Official academic transcript
- Language proficiency certificate, if applicable
- Major at home university (students will be assigned to a similar school/department and major at Fudan based on major at home university)

There is no requirement for letters of recommendation.

We CAN host students with Chinese Passports or students with travel documents from Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan, but CANNOT provide on-campus housing.

Academic Requirements

GPA: Minimum 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent scores)

Language Requirements

- ▶ **Chinese Language Program:** No language requirements
- ▶ **Students from non-Chinese-native countries:**
To take Chinese-taught Courses: **HSK level 5 (score above 210)**
- ▶ **Students from non-English-native countries:**
To take English-taught Courses: TOEFL ibt 90 or 4.5, or IELTS test score 6.5 (no items below 6.0)
TOEFL MyBest Scores are acceptable.

Is airport pick-up service available?

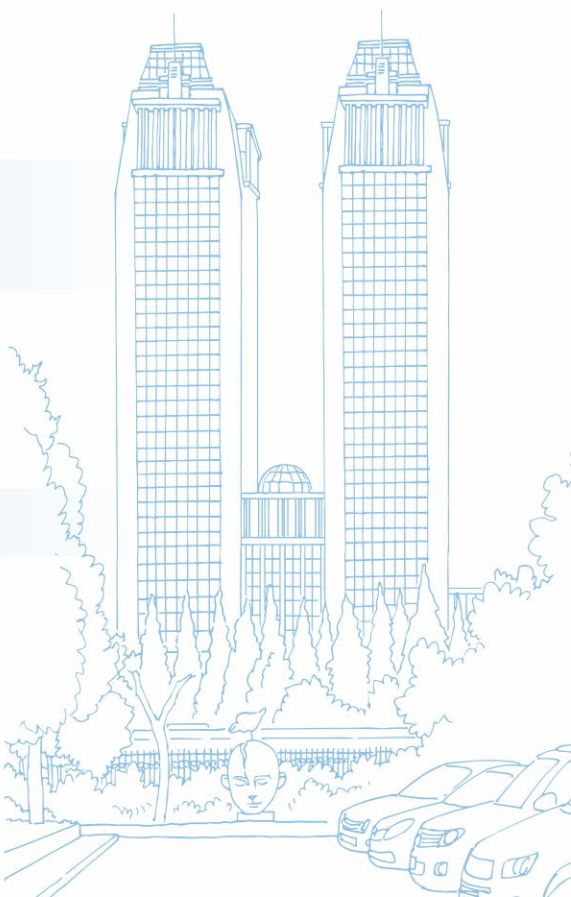
No.

Medical insurance

Are exchange students required to purchase a compulsory medical insurance plan?

Insurance is compulsory for all incoming students (further details will be provided in guidelines for students)

Is purchase of medical insurance recommended?

Purchase of medical insurance or accident insurance in home country as a supplement to Compulsory Medical Insurance is recommended.

Visa Requirements

Are exchange students required to obtain a student visa?

Yes. Chinese Student Visa type: X1 or X2.

X1 visa – two semester exchange

X2 visa – one semester exchange

(X2 holders are able to apply for an extra enter chance during the exchange)

Refer to visa requirements on local consulates' websites.

Is there any physical examination needed?

Students must complete physical examination after enrollment at Fudan if they stay in the mainland of China for more than 180 days. Physical exam costs around RMB660 yuan and Resident Permit costs around RMB400 yuan.

Physical examination after enrollment at Fudan is recommended because the verification of home physical examination record will probably fail due to different physical examination system.

Are exchange students allowed to do off-campus internship?

General Advanced and Senior Advanced students may apply for off-campus internship but need to submit internship notation in advance.

Chinese language students MAY NOT BE ABLE TO apply for off-campus internship.

Estimated Expenses per Semester (approx. 4 months)

University-administered accommodation Lodging Fees

Main Building:
Single Room: **120** Yuan/person/day
Double Room (two beds in one dorm room): **80** Yuan/person/day

Supplementary Building:
Single Room: **65** Yuan/person/day

RMB800 for room reservation (prepaid, counted as part of rent)
RMB200 as Room and Key Deposit (Refundable)

***Important notes:**
Due to limited available spots, we cannot guarantee on-campus housing.

We CAN host students with Chinese Passports or students with travel documents from Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan, but CANNOT provide on-campus housing.

Private accommodation	Inns and hotels (close to campus) 3000-6000 RMB/month
Food/Meals	Around 6000 RMB for one semester
Personal expenses	Around 1000 RMB/month (laundry, sundries, transportation)
Academic expenses e.g. books	Around 500 RMB for one semester
Insurance	400 RMB/semester
Mid-term course dropping fee (for undergraduate students)	If students apply to drop a course during mid-term, they will have to pay a fee.

University-Administered / On-Campus Accommodation

Is university-administered accommodation available for exchange students?

Yes, International students can apply. (Students of Chinese nationality cannot apply)
Housing fee and utilities will be counted separately.

Is availability guaranteed?

Not guaranteed. Exchange students apply online by themselves. Due to limited available spots, only few students will be able to reserve a spot during dormitory online reservation period. It's first come, first serve.

What is the application procedure?

Instructions will be sent to the nominated students .

Is accommodation available over semester breaks?

Available only for exchange students staying for two semesters.
Over semester breaks accommodation fees will be counted by days.

If university-administered accommodation is not available, will there be any assistance in finding private housing?

How many teaching weeks are there in a semester?

18 weeks per semester (16 teaching weeks + 2 exam weeks)

How is a credit point defined?

One instruction hour (45 minutes) per week throughout the semester stands for one credit at Fudan. An academic semester includes 18 weeks.

What is a typical/normal course load per semester?

6-15 credits for one semester (2-8 courses)
(10 credits per semester on average)

Are students allowed to take cross-faculty courses? If yes, are there any restrictions?

Yes.
As long as the courses can be registered online successfully.

Most favored faculties?

International Cultural Exchange School; School of Economics/Management/ International Relations & Public Affairs/Social Development & Public Policy etc.
