### Course information

You can search for courses in two ways. This is explained in detail on the '[choosing courses](#)' page of the website for study abroad and exchange students.

#### **Course Level**

You can use the course code to determine the year of a course and whether it's undergraduate or postgraduate. Codes that start with a 1, 2, 3, or 4 are generally undergraduate, and codes that start with a 5, 6, or 7 are postgraduate. Undergraduate students are generally not eligible to take postgraduate courses, as completion of an undergraduate degree (or equivalent) is typically a pre-requisite for approval.

#### **Campus**

Adelaide University is a multi-campus University. Study abroad and exchange students can study courses across multiple campuses.

When choosing your courses, please pay attention to the campus where the course is being taught as you may need to consider travel time. We suggest that you select courses offered at no more than two different campuses.

The campus information is displayed in the course information section on each course page. Some courses may be taught at multiple campuses during the same study period, and you will get to nominate the teaching location when enrolling.

In addition, 100% online courses cannot make up more than one third of your total course enrolments.

#### **Availability**

Not all AU courses are available to study abroad and exchange students. As a guide, available courses will be identified in the course information section on the course page (yes or no).

The 'Fee Group' label applies only to study abroad (fee-paying) students.

## Credit equivalencies and study load

Study load and credit equivalencies

As an international student, it is an Australian student visa requirement that you study ‘full-time’ (meaning a *minimum* of 18 units per semester – generally 3 courses). A 100% study load is 24 units per semester (generally four courses).

In other words, per semester, students must enrol into:

- a maximum of 24 units (usually four courses), or
- a minimum of 18 units (usually three courses).

A general guide on credit equivalencies is below:

## Visa information

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| Australian Student Visa | <p>As necessary, eligible students will be issued a Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) to apply for an Australian student visa. More detail will be sent to students as part of our admissions process.</p> <p>Adelaide University can't assist with student visa applications, or any other type of visa applications. 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| Overseas Student Health Cover | <p>Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) is compulsory for all international students on a student visa. You can elect for Adelaide University to arrange your OSHC for you in your application (details provided at the point of offer) through Adelaide University's preferred provider (Bupa), or you may choose your own approved provider. Costs apply.</p> <p>There are some exceptions: you don't need OSHC if you're covered under specific Reciprocal Health Care Agreements. This currently includes students from Belgium, Norway, and Sweden. 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| Official Transcripts | <p>Global Learning will order the official transcript on the students' behalf upon release of their final grades and completion of the program.</p> <p>Transcripts will be issued digitally via the platform My eEquals. This platform allows students to securely share with their home university.
